On behalf of its members, the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI)<sup>1</sup> appreciates the opportunity to review and provide comments on the Draft Regulatory Issue Summary related to personnel access authorization requirements for non-immigrant foreign nationals working at nuclear power plants.

In a Federal Register Notice dated March 31, 2020, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission requested that stakeholder comments be submitted by April 30, 2020. NEI requests an extension of the comment period by 90 days to Monday, June 29, 2020.
