This refers to the routine, unannounced emergency preparedness inspection conducted by Mr. Ira Cohen of this office on April 23-27, 1984 at the R. E. Ginna Nuclear Power Plant of activities authorized by NRC License No. DPR-18 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Cohen and yourself and members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection and subsequent follow-up discussions between Messrs. Crocker and Cohen and yourself on May 3, 1984 concerning open items from a previous emergency preparedness appraisal. It is our understanding in regard to items 3.01, 3.02 and 3.03 as shown in paragraph 3 of the enclosed report that corrective actions will be completed by May 30, 1984 and that for item 3.04, a completion date will be determined shortly after a discussion between members of your staff and our inspectors.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the Office of Inspection and Enforcement Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Based on the results of this inspection, it appears that one of your activities was not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements, as set forth in the Notice of Violation, enclosed herewith as Appendix A. This violation has been categorized by severity level in accordance with the revised NRC Enforcement Policy (10 CFR 2, Appendix C), published in the Federal Register Notice (FR 9987) dated March 8, 1984. You are required to respond to this letter and in preparing your response, you should follow the instructions in Appendix A. In addition, seven items were identified that should be considered for improvement. These items are enclosed herewith as Appendix B. You are requested to provide to this office within 30 days of the date of this letter, correction action for each item of concern or provide written justification as to why you believe correction should not be made.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and the enclosure will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room unless you notify this office, by telephone, within ten days of the date of this letter and submit written application to withhold information contained therein within thirty days of the date of this letter. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.790(b)(1). The telephone notification of your intent to request

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withholding, or any request for an extension of the 10-day period which you believe necessary, should be made to the Supervisor, Files, Mail and Records, USNRC Region I, at (215) 337-5223.

The responses directed by this letter and the accompanying Notice are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.

Your cooperation with us in this matter is appreciated.
