MEMORANDUM AND CRDER (Granting Extension of Time for Filing Petition for Hearing)

On or about July 2, 1984, Intervenors requested a reasonable extension of time to permit Intervenors to determine whether certain emergency planning commitments had been met. *Gounsel for Applicant reported to the Board in a July 13 letter that, on the basis of certain agreements, Applicant supports Intervenors' revised request for an extension of time until September 14, 1984 in which Intervenors may file any petition for hearing under the emergency planning stipulation.
