Pursuant to delegation by the Commission dated December 29, 1972, published in the Federal Register, 37 F.R. 28710 (1972) and Sections 2.105, 2.700, 2.702, 2.714, 2.714a, 2.717 and 2.721 of the Commission's Regulations, all as amended, an Atomic Safety and Licensing Board is being established in the following proceeding to rule on petitions for leave to intervene and/or requests for hearing and to preside over the proceeding in the event that a hearing is ordered.

This Board is being established pursuant to a notice published by the Commission on June 7, 1984 in the Federal Register (49 F.R. 23715-18) entitled, "Consideration of Issuance of Amendments to Facility Operating Licenses and Proposed no Significant Hazards Consideration Determination and Opportunity for Hearing". The amendments would allow spent fuel pool storage capacity expansion from 621 to 1404 spaces for each spent fuel pool. The proposed expansion is to be achieved by


reracking each spent fuel pool with two discrete regions, within each pool.
