CONSTRUCTION FATALITY (HEART ATTACK) SUBJECT:

A pipefitter employed by Pullman Power Products died of an apparent heart attack on July 13, 1984 while performing contract work on Unit 2. A co-worker stated that the individual complained of not feeling well and laid down under the scaffolding on which they were working. He was found dead a short time later. The man was 42 years old and had no known history of heart ailments. He was pronounced dead on arrival at a local hospital.
