SUBJECT: ARKANSAS NUCLEAR ONE SECURITY PLAN, REVISION 34

This acknowledges the receipt of your letter dated September 22, 1995 (OCAN099504) by which you transmitted Revision 34 to your Industrial Security Plan.

We have reviewed the changes in your letter and attachments and determined that the following changes are consistent with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p), and are therefore acceptable.

- Section 5.2.5.1.6. The change to this section of the Security Plan deletes the requirement for separate access control to reactor containments, and is consistent with recent changes to 10 CFR 73.55(d)(8) as published in the Federal Register. Access to the reactor building personnel hatches is controlled only at the vital island boundary. Additional access control measures at the personnel hatches or other accessible pathways into the reactor building is not required when they are located within the vital island.
- Section 12. The change to this section of the Security Plan pertains to establishing, implementing and maintaining written procedures. This change replaces requirements that were previously removed from Technical Specifications, as provided for in Generic Letter 93-07.

However, we have determined that additional changes to Section 12 of the Security Plan addressing "audit surveillance requirement" are inconsistent with regulatory requirements and can not be approved under the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p). Specifically, you have proposed that "flexible guidance" be applied to audit intervals, and that audit frequency be modified to include "a maximum allowable extension not to exceed 25 percent of the surveillance interval." Section 4.0.2 of your Technical Specifications currently provides this degree of flexibility for your surveillance intervals, but not for your audit intervals. You should resubmit a corrected plan page in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(p), or submit a request for plan change pursuant to 10 CFR 50.90.

Specific audit frequencies for areas within the security and safeguards programs are established by law as specified in 10 CFR 50.54(p)(3) - for the Safeguards Contingency Plan; 10 CFR 73.55(g)(4) - for the overall site security program; 10 CFR 26.80(a) - for the Fitness-for-Duty program; and 10 CFR 73.56(g)(1) and (2) - for the Access Authorization Program.

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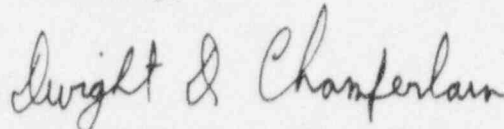
