SUBJECT: RESOLUTION OF REGULATORY EFFECTIVENESS REVIEW (RER) FINDINGS,
TURKEY POINT POWER PLANT UNITS 3 AND 4

In your letter of May 11, 1984 you stated, among other things, that (i) a consultant was being sought to evaluate the entire Turkey Point security system, (ii) your Engineering Department was performing a drawing review regarding the vital equipment contained in our report and (iii) a Company RER Task Force had been established to evaluate alternatives and make recommendations for resolutions of NRC's RER concerns. Since these are considered to be important matters, we would appreciate receiving a report on the progress you have made to date and expected dates of completion of the effort.

Please respond to these concerns within 30 days of receipt of this letter.


