EP-4-010, Toxic Chemical Contingency Procedure is incomplete and therefore not PORC approved. The completion of the Toxic Chemical Contingency Program at Waterford 3 SES is contingent on the update of W3SES FSAR Section 2.2 (Commitment W3P83-2540A). In addition, effort is being directed at the development of the definition of a toxic chemical shelter and the associated support requirements.

The NRC will be kept apprised of our progress in the development of Waterford 3 SES Toxic Chemical Contingency Program, through contact with Region IV and headquarters staff.
