Subject: Environmental Protection Plan for Comanche Peak Steam
Electric Station (Units 1 and 2)

My letter to R. J. Gary dated February 21, 1984, provided your staff with the Comanche Peak Draft Environmental Protection Plan for comment. Your staff's comments were discussed with the NRC technical reviewers and John Stefano of my staff in a conference call held on April 3, 1984. Several changes were proposed pertaining to Sections 4.2.1 and 4.2.2 of the Plan ("Groundwater Levels and Station Water Use Monitoring", and "Water Treatment Facility Outages Impact Assessment and Reporting", respectively), which are documented in B. R. Clements letter to me dated April 6, 1984.

The NRR staff has reviewed the April 6, 1984 letter and finds that the changes proposed therein conform with those discussed during the conference call and indicated as being acceptable. However, the staff wishes to point out that a more appropriate reference to the Comanche Peak FES-OL (second paragraph of the April 6, 1984 letter) would be Figure 4.3 as opposed to Table 5.2. The Final Environmental Protection Plan will reflect the changes agreed to and documented in the April 6, 1984 letter and, will reference Figure 4.3 of the FES-OL, accordingly.

This letter serves to satisfactorily resolve Technical Specification Item 5, listed among the issues documented in my letter to R. J. Gary dated January 24, 1984.
