Gentlemen:

We have received the attached Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) letter dated September 14, 1984, which provided a supplemental interim finding on the adequacy of offsite planning for the Callaway Nuclear Power Plant. This interim finding states that there is reasonable assurance that the plans and preparedness are adequate to protect the public health and safety in the vicinity of Callaway. Pending a formal finding under 44 CFR 350, this constitutes FEMA's most recent review on offsite planning and preparedness for the State of Missouri and relevant local jurisdictions around the Callaway site.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter and the attachment will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room.
