ORDER

On April 9, 1984, the New York Public Interest Research Group (NYPIRG) filed with the Commission a "Petition for Suspension of Operation of Indian Point Units 2 and 3." NYPIRG supplemented this request on June 12, 1984. In these filings, NYPIRG asked for immediate shutdown of the Indian Point units for emergency planning and preparedness deficiencies.

By this Order we are referring the NYPIRG request, as supplemented, to the Director, NRC Office of Inspection and Enforcement, for treatment pursuant to 10 C.F.R. 2.206. If final resolution will take a


