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SUBJECT: ACTIONS IN RESPONSE TO HURRICANE 'JOSEPHINE'

Region II is monitoring the position of Hurricane "Josephine," which was upgraded to hurricane status from a tropical storm at 2:30 p.m. (EDT) yesterday by the National Weather Service.

As of noon today, the storm was centered near latitude 27.8 north and longitude 72.7 west. This position is 380 miles east northeast of Freeport, Grand Bahamas. The storm is drifting very slowly toward the northwest at about five miles an hour and is expected to continue this movement during the day. Maximum sustained winds are near 85 miles an hour. There is an eight percent probability that the hurricane will be within 65 miles of Wilmington, North Carolina, by 8 a.m. Saturday, October 13.

Present media coverage of the storm does not involve NRC-licensed activities.

This information is current as of noon today.
