The staff and a representative of the Union Electric Company briefed the Commission on the readiness of the Union Electric Company for a full power operating license at Callaway, Unit 1.

The Commission voted 5-0 to authorize the staff to issue a full power operating license amendment after it is satisfied that the utility is ready to proceed beyond low power operation and after it is satisfied that the allegations raised by the Government Accountability Project will not preclude full power operation.
