This is an update to a previous report submitted on May 15, 1984. The condition for which the report was submitted began on April 8, 1984, when fire door 1A320 to the Main Steam Tunnel Room was blocked open to support planned maintenance activities. Fire watches were established in accordance with Technical Specification 3.7.7. The maintenance outage is continuing and work is still being performed in the Main Steam Tunnel. Fire watches will be continued until the fire door is restored. This is submitted as a Special Report pursuant to Technical Specification 6.9.2. This is a final report.
