



This is of significant concern to us in as much as the nuclear plant project at Shoreham is located in the district which I represent on the Suffolk County Legislature.

We are given to understand that relatively limited installation has been done to set in place the dome at the top of the plant project. This is stated in relative terms to us because the dome is not installed with nearly as much enforced support as compared with the enforced, three to four foot thick concrete walls around the plant. If this be the case, inquiry is made to you as to whether this is a safety feature that is, or should be, of concern to the public.

Your prompt attention and reply to the foregoing would be greatly appreciated.
