



SUBJECT: I & E Inspection Report 84-16

REFERENCE: NRC Letter dated June 22, 1984

Dear Mr. Johnson:

This letter is in response to the Nctice of Violation received as a result of inspections conducted at Fort St. Vrain during the period June 4-5, 1984. The following response to the items contained in the Notice of Violation is hereby submitted:

A. Shift Turnover Procedure

Technical Specifications, Paragraph 7.4.a. requires that: "Written procedures shall be established, implemented and maintained covering the activities referenced below:

1. The applicable procedures recommended in 'spendix A of Regulatory Guide 1.33, November 1972."

Appendix A to Regulatory Guide 1.33, November 1972, requires that there be an administrative procedure for shift and relief turnover.

Contrary to the above, there was no procedure for shift turnover in effect on June 4, 1984.

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This is a Severity Level IV Violation (Supplement I.D.) (50-267/8416-01).

(1) The corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved:

A Shift Turnover Procedure is being written using the INPO Good Practice OP-201 as a reference guide document. The procedure is presently in draft form and is being routed throughout various departments for comment. The procedure will define shift turnover requirements for the Shift Supervisor, Reactor Operator, Equipment Operator and Auxiliary Tender positions.

(2) Corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations:

The Shift Turnover Procedure will be an administrative procedure and will be incorporated into the Station Manager Administrative Procedure Manual (SMAP). In addition, training for all affected personnel on the new procedure will be accomplished prior to implementation.

(3) The date when full compliance will be achieved:

Full compliance will be achieved by August 10, 1984.
