Dear Mr. Querio:

Your letter of June 15, 1984, requested that a group of candidates be permitted to take their license examinations prior to completion of their observation training. We have determined that these candidates can take the examinations as stated, but we will not issue licenses to those candidates until we receive written certification that each candidate has completed the required observation training. Messrs. Scheidecker, Allen, and Pleniewicz do not have to participate in the additional training and if they successfully complete the examinations we will issue licenses to these individuals.

The 120 hours of observation training for the candidates should be accomplished in three (3) forty-hour weeks, except for Mr. Magnuson, who will be required to complete an additional forty hours beyond the 120 hours committed by your letter.
