JUSTIFICATION FOR INDIVIDUAL FEDERAL REGISTER SHOLLY NOTICE

CRYSTAL RIVER UNIT 3

Florida Power Corporation submitted TSCR 121 requesting TS changes to permit auxiliary building ventilation system inoperability for up to 12 hours for maintenance purposes, as well as for surveillance testing as presently allowed. This request had been treated in a routine manner until the PM was informed recently that evaluation by the licensee indicates that the condition of certain system dampers (which initially prompted the request) is deteriorating. It is feared that failure of the dampers might cause fan damage and require more extended plant shutdown. Availability of parts and completion of engineering will permit repair/replacement of the dampers in October 1984. The system design is such that the necessary repairs cannot be performed while any ventilation fans are operating. The present TS, as interpreted by Region II, requires reactor shutdown if more than one pair of exhaust fans is inoperable. Since waiting for the October monthly notice would not permit issuance of the amendment before late November, issuance of an individual notice is requested to minimize the period of potential plant shutdown.
