Subject: Reactor Trip With Engineered Safety Feature (ESF) Actuation

At 1:18 p.m. on July 25, 1984, with the reactor at 70% power, a low pressure reactor trip and high head safety injection occurred following the surveillance testing of power operated relief valves (PORV). An unusual event was declared at 1:20 p.m. The surveillance test had been completed apparently satisfactorily and the PORV blocking valve has been commanded open (the PORV indicated shut). Immediate indications of an open PORV, i.e., tail pipe high temperature, plus pressurizer back-up heaters energizing, low pressure indications, etc., were received. Power was reduced and the blocking valve was commanded shut; however, not before pressure had been reduced to the reactor trip and safety injection set points. The reactor is stable in hot standby. Safety injection was terminated manually to prevent the plant from going solid. The unusual event was terminated at 1:56 p.m.

The duration of the outage is unknown.

The States of New Jersey and Delaware have been notified.
