SUBJECT: Status Report on Offsite Radiological Emergency Planning
for the Braidwood Nuclear Power Station

On April 27, 1984, we provided your office with a status report on offsite radiological emergency preparedness (REP) for the Braidwood Nuclear Power Station (NPS). A copy of the report and transmittal memorandum are attached.

Recently, your office requested an additional interim finding concerning offsite REP for the Braidwood NPS to be provided to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) by August 15, 1984.

This memorandum will confirm a conversation between Margaret Lawless of my staff and Don Perrotti, NRC, on July 16, 1984. At that time, Ms. Lawless stated that the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has no additional substantive information to provide regarding offsite planning for the Braidwood site. This is due to changes in the plans development schedule of the Illinois Emergency Services and Disaster Agency (IESDA). Originally, the State anticipated publishing a preliminary draft plan by July 15, 1984, and a review document by October 1984. The revised dates for these planned accomplishments are now January 1985 and March/April 1985 respectively.
