To the extent indicated below,* the Board grants the Motion To Compel The NRC Staff and Motion To Delay Depositions and Extend Deadline For Discovery Of The NRC Staff, which had been filed by the Union of Concerned Scientists (UCS) on October 17, 1984.

1. On October 19, 1984, the Staff shall hand deliver to UCS the balance of its responses to UCS's first set of interrogatories which had been served on September 4, 1984, as well as a full response to interrogatory 2 h. as required by § 2.740b(b).

After hearing arguments by counsel for UCS and the Staff during the course of two conference calls on October 18, 1984, in a third conference call to all parties' counsel on that date, Judge Wolfe read off the contents of this Order.

- 2. The time for UCS's completion of discovery via the taking of the depositions only of Staff's witnesses on the training issue is extended from October 29 to November 6, 1984. UCS shall proceed to take these depositions beginning on November 5, 1984. In return for this extension of time, counsel for UCS suggested and agreed to forgo submitting any further written interrogatories to the Staff.
- 3. Except as set forth above, the schedule set forth in the Board's Memorandum and Order of September 19, 1984 (unpublished) remains unchanged.
