We hereby request a two-week extension of time to respond to the NRC. This extension was discussed today with the acting NRC Project Manager for Millstone Unit No. 3, Mr. P. O'Connor. The additional time is necessary to prepare the supporting material for a full and complete response, which we believe the Staff should find acceptable.


