## Gentlemen:

We have received a copy of your letter dated August 27, 1984, which transmitted your Second 10 -Year Inservice Inspection Progran and requested relief from certain ASME Code requirements for Arkansas Nuclear One Unit No. 1. Fees pursuant to 10 CFR 170 were not remitted with your request.

Since your application was filed after the June 20,1984 effective date of the revision to 10 CFR 170 (copy enclosed) on fees, it is subject to the provistion of the revised rule. This rule requires licensees to remit an application fee of $\$ 150$ with each application for ilcense amendment, relief, exemption and other requests. Therefore, it is requested that your Company remft the required application fee of $\$ 150$ for your August 27 request. The ONRR staff has informed us that they consider this submittal to be a new application which requires MRC review and approval in order to determine that the proyram meets the requirements of Section XI of the 1980 ASVE Boiler and Pressure Vessel Code and Addenda.
