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MEMORANDUM

In accordance with our order of September 28, 1984, intervenor FOE has now filed a notice of appeal from the Licensing Board's second partial initial decision (LBP-84-31) and its related October 5, 1984, order denying FOE's motion to reopen. Two other appeals and supporting briefs have already been filed with regard to LBP-84-31 by intervenors LEA and AWPP. The purpose of this memorandum is to clarify the time for filing responsive briefs to all three appeals. Under 10 C.F.R. § 2.762(c), applicant's one brief in combined response to LEA, AWPP, and FOE is due for filing 30 days, and the NRC staff's single brief is due 40


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days, after service of FOE's brief.<sup>1</sup>

FOE has also moved for a stay of LBP-84-31. Replies to this motion are due in accordance with 10 C.F.R. § 2.788.
