I. Shoreham Order

The Commission, by a vote of 5-0,\* approved an order in which it (1) determined that 10 CFR 50.57(c) should not be read to make General Design Criteria 17 inapplicable to low power operation; (2) vacated the Licensing Board's order of April 6, 1984 to the extent that it is inconsistent with this order; and (3) ordered the Licensing Board to conduct further proceedings in accordance with the Commission's rules.
