SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION REPORT 50-298/95-13

This refers to the inspection conducted by Messrs. M. Runyan and C. Myers of this office on September 25-29. 1995, at the Cooper Nuclear Station facility and during telephone conference calls conducted October 3-4. 1995. The purpose of the inspection was to determine whether activities authorized by the license were conducted safely and in accordance with NRC requirements. On October 4. 1995, the findings were discussed by telephone with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during the inspection are identified in the report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observation of activities in progress. The results of this inspection are documented in the enclosed report.

The inspection identified a concern regarding the operability of four of your motor-operated valves that had been previously identified in a contractor study as being susceptible to pressure locking. Specifically, the inspectors questioned the adequacy of the engineering evaluation that demonstrated that the motor-operated valves were capable of opening in a pressure-locked condition. Your staff aggressively pursued this concern and adequately demonstrated the operability of the valves by performing a detailed engineering evaluation using the latest pressure-locking analysis methodology available to the industry. Our initial concerns were consequently resolved during conference calls conducted on October 3 and 4, 1995. Although the operability issue was adequately resolved, the inspection did identify one unresolved item concerning documentation of the initial operability assessment of the valves and the adequacy of the original engineering basis. We will review this aspect during a future inspection.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice." a copy of this letter and its enclosures will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
