The Board partially accepts the suggestions of the parties set forth in the Licensee's letter dated October 30, 1984 and directs as follows:

- 1. By no later than November 21, 1984, the parties shall advise (a) whether they request that, pursuant to § 2.749, the Board should proceed to rule upon the issue of the applicability of Table S-4, as posed in Consolidated Contention 1, (b) whether they request that, in so proceeding, the Board should treat the Licensee's, the Staff's, and Concerned Citizens of Louisa County's previous submissions as being motions for partial summary disposition, and (c) whether they agree that the motions for partial summary disposition do not raise any genuine issues of material fact.
- 2. Within thirty (30) days after service of the Board's Order ruling upon the issue of the applicability of Table S-4, any further motions for summary disposition shall be filed with respect to the issues posed by Consolidated Contention 1.

If, by November 21, 1984, the parties advise that they do not request that the Board should proceed to rule upon the issue of the applicability of Table S-4, by December 17, 1984, the parties will advise whether any motions for summary disposition will be filed with respect to any other issue(s) posed by Consolidated Contention 1. Such motions(s) shall be filed by January 5, 1985.
