MEMORANDUM (Attorney-Dictated Testimony)

We appreciate Applicants' candor in its opposition to CASE's motion for sanctions, filed yesterday, in stating, on page 4 that:

Counsel then . . . dictated draft testimony to a court reporter on October 3.

This does not, however, accord with the Board's expectation concerning the drafting of testimony. We had thought that Mr. Brandt was going to dictate his own testimony, in lieu of testifying live.
