Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted under the Resident Inspection Program by Messrs. J. E. Cummins and H. S. Phillips of this office and NRC contract personnel during the period May 19, 1984, through July 21, 1984, of activities authorized by NRC Construction Permits CPPR-126 and CPPR-127 for the Comanche Peak Facility, Units 1 and 2, and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. J. T. Merritt and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection included plant status, action on previous NRC inspection findings, action on licensee identified design/construction deficiencies (10 CFR Part 50.55(e) reports), review of quality assurance manuals/procedures, quality assurance/control of construction activities, 10 CFR Part 21 inspection, inspection and enforcement bulletin followup, battery room ventilation, licensee investigation of drug use at Comanche Peak Steam Electric Station, and plant tours. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors. These findings are documented in the enclosed inspection report.

During this inspection, it was found that certain of your activities were in violation of NRC requirements. Consequently, you are required to respond to these violations, in writing, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Your response should be based on the specifics contained in the Notice of Violation enclosed with this letter.

Two unresolved items are identified in paragraphs 6 and 9 of the enclosed inspection report.
