Dear Mr. Link:

We have received the enclosed Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) correspondence dated September 5, 1995 transmitting the FEMA evaluation report for the December 6, 1994 Emergency Preparedness Exercise at the Point Beach Nuclear Power Plant.

Two Deficiencies and thirteen Areas Requiring Corrective Action (ARCA) were identified during the December 6, 1994 exercise. During the April 26, 1995 Zion Exercise, both Deficiencies and seven of the ARCA were successfully demonstrated.

We fully recognize that any remaining corrective actions to be implemented may involve parties and political institutions which are not under your direct control. Nonetheless, we expect that assistance, if appropriate, will be extended.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790 of the Commission's regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed FEMA correspondence will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.
