On 9/1/84 R.L. Anthony/FOE filed a metien with LR requesting that the Partial Initial Decision on our Contentions V-52 & 5b be set aside and that the rederd be responed and a schecule for discovery be set up.

On 9/7/84 LB refused to stay its decision. We appealed this decision and affidevits of 9/21/84 on 9/24/84 to the Appeal Board.

The Appeal Heard's Order of 9/28/84 extended our time of appeal to 15 days from the date of LB's order disposing of our 9/1, motion. That LB Order was served on 10/9/84 and we are new appealing within the 15 days of service as specified by the Beard.

Anthony/FOE hereby appeals the decision, LBP -84-31 on our Contentions V-3a & 3b and the authorizing of a license to PECo for low power testing, and also we appeal LB's Order, served 10/9, denying our Metion of 9/1/84.

We also petition the Board to stay the authorization of a low power license for PECo. We support this petition under lOCFR Sec. 2.778 (o) as follows. 1. The reacter building is not able to withstand everpressures from postulated external explosions. The nuclear fuel was not brought to the plant in accordance with NRC regulations, and AEA and NEPA. A decision on this is pending in the U.S. Third Circuit Court (our appeal # 84-3409). 2. If Limerick is operated, an inexerable precess will start which will threaten my safety, increace electric rates, impair regional economy, and force me to move from the area. 3. A stay sould delay PECo's testing, but 4. sublic health and safety, the local economy, PECo's selveney, and prespects for safe energy altenatives predeminate ever all else.

We move for an immediate stay on LBP-84-31 and authorizing a low power license.
