In ruling on TMIA's Motion to Extend Discovery Period, the Licensing Board, last Friday, October 26, 1984, permitted TMIA to ask an additional interrogatory regarding a meeting held on the afternoon of March 29, 1979 at which hydrogen production was apparently discussed. The Board permitted TMIA to ask this interrogatory of two individuals and directed that GPU make good faith efforts to have them answer the interrogatory.
