Dear Chairman Hayt:

My name is Moreland Bollinger. I am the President of the Owen J. Roberts Teachers Association. I have been a Social Studies teacher at Owen J. Roberts for nineteen years. My professional background includes the presidency of our local association for the past year, negotiation chairperson for six years prior to that, and a member of the negotiation team for fourteen years.

The concern of our association is that a plan for emergency action will be passed without specific, knowledge of the number of supervisory personnel available to deal with the students. Since there has been no specific duty assignment, time period, or location, finalized, our staff has not been able to make a committeent. Our contract only delineates the normal school day, and the issue here is after school hours either on or off campus. Firthermore, there are no designated responsibilities. I feel no plan should be approved until problems such as the above, have been adequately resolved. At the current time this asse is not being edgressed in our preparation for a new contract.
