M83657 AND M83658)

Dear Mr. Hunger:

By letter dated September 18, 1992, Philadelphia Electric Company (PECO, now PECO Energy Company) committed to submit a summary report regarding the results of its programs to resolve issues raised in Generic Letter 87-02, Supplement 1, "Verification of Seismic Adequacy of Mechanical and Electrical Equipment in Operating Reactors, Unresolved Safety Issue (USI) A-46," by November 20, 1995. In a separate letter dated September 18, 1992, PECO committed to submit the results of its Individual Plant Examination for External Event (IPEEE) by November 20, 1995.

In a letter dated September 29, 1995, PECO proposed to revise the above commitments such that the GL 87-02 and IPEEE reports would be submitted by May 31, 1996, rather than November 20, 1995. In proposing the change, PECO stated that during walkdowns associated with the USI A-46 and IPEEE projects, PECO had identified a number of items which would require additional time to resolve.

During the first half of 1995, the NRC staff audited PECO's A-46 walkdowns. The results of these audits are documented in a letter dated June 15, 1995. Based on the NRC audits and the licensee's September 29, 1995 letter, the staff concludes that PECO is making satisfactory progress toward the


