Dear Administrative Judges:

This memorializes a phone call on November 1, 1984 between Judge Bloch and the undersigned Staff counsel, in which the Staff requested an extension of time until January 1984 to respond to "CASE's First Motion for Summary Disposition Regarding Certain Aspects for the Implementation of Applicants' Design and QA/QC for Design in the form of Affidavit of Jack Doyle" (October 6, 1984). Staff counsel indicated that Applicants had no objection to the request, that Staff counsel had not been able to contact Mrs. Ellis concerning the extension. Judge Bloch granted the Staff's request subject to any CASE objection; and requested that a written record be made of this phone call.
