Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted under the Resident Inspector Program by Messrs. G. L. Constable, T. A. Flippo, W. B. Jones, and Ms. K. A. Whittlesey of this office during the period July 1 through August 31, 1984, of activities authorized by NRC Construction Permit CPPR-103 for the Waterford Steam Electric Station, Unit 3, and to the discussion of our findings with members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection included Three Mile Island (TMI) open items, followup on 50.55(e) items, maintenance test witnessing, inquiry team exit meeting, review Condition Identification and Work Authorization (CIWA) closure, high pressure safety injection operability check, review of corrective actions, nondestructive examination of concrete common foundation basemat, and general employee training. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors. These findings are documented in the enclosed inspection report.

During this inspection, it was found that certain of your activities were in violation of NRC requirements. Consequently, you are required to respond to these violations, in writing, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Your response should be based on the specifics contained in the Notice of Violation enclosed with this letter.
