The Commission was briefed by the NRC staff on the Technical Training Program. The Commission expressed interest in obtaining further information on the following specific items.

- 1) A break-down for the last three fiscal years of the number of students for each of the technical training curriculum areas and a break-down of staff who are taking technical courses for professional development other than for formal qualification, development, or training programs.
- Plans for changes in agency training to ensure inspectors are adequately trained in areas of developing technologies (e.g., PRA, digital instrumentation and control, etc.).
- Plans and dates when satellite links will be functional between the Technical Training Center, the regional offices, and headquarters for use in training.
