
This letter responds to your appeal dated June 21, 1990. For reasons specified below your appeal is granted in part and denied in part.

I cannot find any documents which are responsive to specification "c" of your initial request. No Commissioner staff office provided written comments on the paper. Likewise, there is no record of any written request by Commissioner Roberts that SECY-89-247 be considered as a "Notation Vote." This is not unusual. Commissioner Offices frequently make such requests orally. Accordingly, I have denied your appeal of the alleged "denial" of those records requested under specification "c".

With respect to your appeal of the denial of the individual Commission vote sheets on SECY-89-247, the Commissioners have reconsidered the matter and released their vote sheets. Copies of the vote sheets are enclosed.

This letter constitutes final agency action on your appeal letter of June 21, 1990. Judicial review of this action is available in the federal district court where you reside or have your place of business or in the Federal District Court for the District of Columbia.
