CHANGES TO THE QQAP

Chapter 2.0, Rev. 7, Program Description

Incorporated Change QA-001 to paragraph 2.1 to clarify that the QQAP is not applicable to the design and fabrication of NRC certified casks for transportation of radioactive waste. This change was previously submitted to the NRC in Letter ST-HL-AE-3856, dated September 12, 1991.

Chapter 3.0, Rev. 6, Conduct of Plant Operations

Change reference paragraph 4.3 to read:

"UFSAR 13.5.2.1 paragraph 4. Emergency Operating Procedures" to update reference. (Editorial change)

Chapter 4.0, Rev. 4, Qualification, Training and Certification of Personnel

Delete redundant paragraph in 5.2.2. (This paragraph was duplicated on pages 2 and 3.) (Editorial change)

Chapter 9.0, Rev. 5, Control of Material

Incorporate Change QA-003 as follows:

Change paragraph 5.3.1 second sentence to read:

"Control of items in storage shall comply with the intent of the requirements of Reference 4.1."

This change is not considered to be a reduction in commitment. Unreviewed Safety Question Evaluation 91-0038 is addressed in the annual Unreviewed Safety Question Evaluation (USQE) Summary submitted to the NRC in Letter ST-HL-AE-3897 issued November 25, 1991.

Chapter 13.0, Rev. 5, Deficiency Control

Incorporate Change QA-002 as follows:

Paragraph 13.2.9, change third sentence to read:

"Once installed, nonconforming items are not energized..."

Add new paragraph 5.2.10 to read:

"Nonconformances identified on installed items will be evaluated for operability."

This change is addressed as USQE 90-0193 in Letter ST-HL-AE-3897 issued November 25, 1991.

Renumber existing paragraph 5.2.10 to 5.2.11.

Chapter 15.0, Rev. 4, Quality Assurance Audit and Surveillance

Paragraph 5.12 - Correct Reference 4.5 to Reference 4.4

Paragraph 5.13 - Correct Reference 4.3 to Reference 4.2

Paragraph 6.1 - Correct Reference 4.7 to Reference 4.5
