- (ii) the total number of reinspections performed. (The tabulation for (e) should provide the same type of information provided in Table B-5 of the Reinspection Program disaggregated by "inspection element" rather than "attribute".)

Interrogatory 12 Supplement: Separately with respect to each "inspector reinspected" listed in Commonwealth Edison Company's First Amended Response to Interrogatory 12(c) of Intervenors' First Set of Interrogatories, state for each "inspection element":

- the number of reinspections performed that conform with initial inspections, and
- the total number of reinspections performed. (The tabulation should provide the same type of information provided in Table B-3 of the Reinspection Program but should be disaggregated by "inspection element" rather than "attribute".)
