Subject: Task Order No. 53, Under Contract No. NRC-03-90-031 Entitled "Electrical Distribution System Functional Inspection -Hope Creek" (Fin L-1527)

In accordance with the task order procedures of the subject contract, this letter definitizes Task Order No. 53. This effort shall be performed in accordance with the enclosed Statement of Work, the Contractor's proposal dated October 21, 1991 and the revision to the proposal dated October 30, 1991, and the following telephonic changes of November 19, 1991:

- Reduce fixed fee by \$337.25 from \$2,090.98 (7.75%) to \$1,753.73 (6.5%).
- 2.) Subtract 3 hours of travel time from each of the four trips scheduled for the following individuals. The travel time for each trip is decreased from 16 hours to 13 hours. As result of the decrease in travel time the labor hours are decreased as follows:

3.) Add the following to paragraph 3, pg. 2 of the Statement of Work:

Scheduled Completion

"The final inspection report shall be delivered no later than March 30, 1992."

4.) Correct the subtotal for travel costs for trips A-D, pages 10-11 of the contractor's proposal to read \$1440 in lieu of \$1430.

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Task Order No. 53 shall be in effect from January 10, 1992 through March 30, 1992, with a cost ceiling of \$91,394.22. The amount of \$89,640.49 represents the total estimated reimbursable costs, and the amount of \$1,753.73 represents the fixed fee.
