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NUREG-0525, Safeguards Summary Event List (SSEL) is comprised of two parts. Vol. 1, issued July 1992, summarizes events that occurred and were reported from pre-NRC through December 31, 1989. Vol. 2, Rev. 3, revised July 1995, summarizes events that occurred from January 1, 1990, through December 31, 1994.

Events which involve only source material, byproduct material, or natural uranium which are not safeguarded under NRC regulations are not included, except for a few events included in the Miscellaneous category because of public interest. Information on events involving nonsafeguarded material is available in NUREG-1272 published annually by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

Events which involve alcohol and drugs, formerly reported in Category IX, have been dropped from the Safeguards Summary Event List. Information on drug and alcohol events is contained in NUREG/CR-5758, Fitness for Duty in the Nuclear Power Industry, Annual Summary of Program Performance Reports, published annually by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

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ABSTRACT

The Safeguards Summary Event List (SSEL), Vol. 2, Rev. 3, provides brief summaries of several hundred safeguards-related events involving nuclear material or facilities regulated by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) which occurred and were reported from January 1, 1990, through December 31, 1994. Because of public interest, the Miscellaneous category includes a few events which involve either source material, byproduct material, or natural uranium which are exempt from safeguards requirements. Events are described under the categories of Bomb-related, Intrusion, Missing and/or Allegedly Stolen, Transportation-related, Tampering/Vandalism, Arson, Firearms, Radiological Sabotage, Nonradiological Sabotage, and Miscellaneous. The information contained in the event descriptions is derived primarily from official NRC reporting channels.

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INTRODUCTION

The Safeguards Summary Event List (SSEL) provides brief summaries of several hundred safeguards-related events involving nuclear materials or facilities regulated by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). The SSEL is comprised of two parts. Vol. 1, issued July 1992, summarizes events that occurred and were reported from pre-NRC through December 31, 1989. Vol. 2, Rev. 3, issued July 1995, summarizes events that occurred January 1, 1990, through December 31, 1994. Because of public interest, the Miscellaneous category includes a few events which involve either byproduct material, source material, or natural uranium which are exempt from safeguards requirements. As the list is intended to provide a broad perspective on the nature of safeguards incidents in the licensed nuclear industry, both unusual and routine events are described. Events have been placed in the several categories described below. Each listing is included in a single category unless it is transportation-related, in which case it is cross-referenced in the Transportation category.

- I. Bomb-Related: Events concerned with explosives or incendiary devices.
Section A: Events in which a bomb or explosive material was located or an explosion occurred at a licensed facility.
Section B: All other bomb-related events (e.g., hoax bomb threats).
- II. Intrusion: Incidents of attempted or actual penetration of a facility's barriers or safeguards systems.
- III. Missing or Allegedly Stolen: Events in which safeguarded material was stolen, alleged to be stolen, discovered missing, or found.
- IV. Transportation-Related: Events typically include incidents where safeguarded material was misrouted or involved in an accident. Material reported missing or stolen during transport, for example, would be included in Category III and cross-referenced in the Transportation category.
- V. Tampering/Vandalism: Incidents of destruction or attempted destruction of property, parts and equipment which do not directly cause a radioactive release.
- VI. Arson: Intentional acts involving incendiary materials resulting in damage to property, equipment or other assets.
- VII. Firearms-Related: Events typically describe the discharge, discovery, or loss of firearms at a licensed facility.
- VIIIA. Radiological Sabotage: Deliberate act directed against a safeguarded activity which could endanger the public health and safety by exposure to radiation.
- VIIIB. Nonradiological Sabotage: Events characterized by the FBI as sabotage but which could not endanger the public health and safety by exposure to radiation.
- IX. Alcohol and Drugs: These events have been dropped from this document and are now contained in NUREG/CR-5758.
- X. Miscellaneous: Events which hold some interest to safeguards and the public but which do not fit into any of the previously described categories.

Each event listed in the body of the report is identified by an alphanumeric code composed of the appropriate category roman numeral, the last two digits of the year in which the event occurred, and a sequential number for that specific year and category. Each incident listing includes the appropriate date and location and a brief description of the event. Descriptions vary in detail according to the amount of data available through NRC reporting channels.

I. BOMB-RELATED EVENTS

SECTION A. Events in which an explosive or incendiary device or material was located or an explosion occurred at or in the vicinity of a licensed facility.

There were no reported events meeting the bomb-related events Section A criteria during 1990, 1991, 1992, 1993, or 1994.



Resolution: The licensee concluded that the caller was angry because he was unable to contact the person he wanted to reach and used the hoax threat to vent his frustration.

Fuel present at site.

Event: Bomb threat. Hoax. At 11:33 a.m., the licensee received a telephonic bomb threat.

Action: An investigation was conducted.

Resolution: Based on an evaluation of the known facts, the licensee determined that the threat was noncredible. Therefore, no search was conducted. The investigation was completed with no perpetrator identified.

Fuel present at site.

Event: Bomb threat. Hoax. At 9:07 p.m., the San Diego Sheriff's Department informed the licensee that they had received a telephonic bomb threat directed at San Onofre from an individual who gave his name and telephone number to the telephone dispatcher who received the call.

Action: The licensee took immediate compensatory measures and contacted the local FBI.

Resolution: The FBI was aware of the caller and noted that the individual had psychological problems and had a previous history of making false bomb reports.

Fuel present at site.

Event: Bomb threat. Hoax. At 2:16 p.m., the central alarm station operator received a telephonic bomb threat from an individual who stated, "I've got a bomb planted there." The caller immediately hung up.

Action: Security implemented contingency response procedures and the appropriate compensatory measures.

Resolution: At 3:55 p.m., the licensee determined that the threat was noncredible and resumed normal operations.

Fuel present at site.

Event: Bomb threat. Hoax. Between 2:23 a.m. and 2:26 a.m., the security shift supervisor received two telephonic bomb threats which stated that the water system and the reactor would blow up.

Action: A search was conducted, and appropriate notifications were made.

Resolution: The search results were negative. The licensee determined that the threats were unsubstantiated.

Action: An investigation was initiated.

Resolution: The licensee determined that the threat was noncredible.

Action: Security precautions were implemented, and appropriate notifications were made.

Resolution: The FBI advised the licensee that the threat was noncredible.

Event: Bomb threat. Hoax. At 2:38 p.m., the licensee received a brief and obscene telephonic bomb threat.

Action: A management evaluation was conducted.

Resolution: The licensee concluded that the threat was noncredible.

Fuel present at site.

Event: Bomb threat. Hoax. At 12:50 a.m., security received a brief telephonic bomb threat from an anonymous female.

Action: Security precautions were implemented, and appropriate notifications were made.

Resolution: The FBI advised the licensee that the threat was noncredible.

Fuel present at site.

Event: Bomb threat. Hoax. At 7:15 p.m., a telephonic bomb threat was received.

Action: A search was conducted, and an investigation was initiated.

Resolution: The licensee determined that the threat was noncredible.

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Plant Status: Units 2 and 3, Operational
Fuel present at site.

Event: Bomb threat. Hoax. At 2:30 p.m., while emptying boxes which were used by the licensee employees to inform management of their concerns, an employee found an envelope addressed to NRC with a threat message visible through the envelope window which said: "Both units will go kaboom."

Action: The envelope was delivered directly to security.

Resolution: The licensee and the FBI determined that the threat was noncredible.

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Plant Status: Operational
Fuel present at site.

Event: Bomb threat. The South Haven, Michigan Police Department notified the licensee that they had received a report from the Van Buren County Mental Health Department that a counselor had just completed an interview with an individual who stated that he knew how to make bombs, had a pick-up for carrying them, knew exactly where the dry cask storage facility was located at Palisades and how to crash the gate.

Action: The licensee implemented measures to address the potential vehicle threat and notified the surrounding law enforcement agencies.

Resolution: The FBI and another mental health counselor interviewed the individual by telephone at his home and concluded that the individual posed no imminent threat to Palisades. However, the subject was taken into custody for hospitalization by the local authorities.

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Plant Status: Units 1 and 2, Operational
Fuel present at site.

Event: Bomb threat. Hoax. At 4:30 p.m., the Philadelphia Electric Company Emergency Telecommunications Service Office in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, received a call from an anonymous individual who stated that there was a van full of C-4 (a high explosive) by the Unit 1 reactor building at Limerick. Limerick was notified.

Action: A search was conducted of the owner-controlled area, the protected area, and all licensee designated vehicles in the protected area, as well as a van belonging to a cleaning contractor.

Resolution: The search results were negative. The licensee management determined that the threat was noncredible.

II-93-01	Date: 02/07/93	Site: Three Mile Island GPU Nuclear Corporation Dauphin County, PA
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Plant Status: Unit 1, Operational
Fuel present at site.

Event: At 6:53 a.m., an unauthorized vehicle drove through the open, but manned, north gate in the owner-controlled area, drove through the parking lot to the protected area, crashed through a gate in the protected area fence, smashed into the turbine building roll-up doors, and eventually came to a halt approximately 63 feet inside the turbine building. The driver exited the vehicle and fled; his whereabouts were not immediately known.

Action: Immediately after the intruder passed through the north gate, security notified the central alarm station who in turn, notified the control room. Designated vital areas were secured with armed personnel and vital access restricted via key cards. A security emergency was declared at 6:55 a.m., a site area emergency was declared at 7:05 a.m., and appropriate notifications were made. At 7:20 a.m., the Pennsylvania State Police arrived on site. At 8:38 a.m., the first search and clear operation began in the turbine building with negative results. At 9 a.m., the U.S. Army 56th Explosive Ordnance Team initiated a check of the vehicle for explosives with negative results. At 10:57 a.m., during the conduct of the second turbine building search and clear operation, the intruder was found underneath circulating water piping on the bottom floor of the turbine building and apprehended by site security. He was released to the Pennsylvania State Police.

Resolution: Augmented security measures have been implemented by the licensee. In addition, because of this event and the February 1993 bombing of the World Trade Center, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission decided to revise the design basis threat for radiological sabotage, 10 CFR 73.1, to include land-based vehicles against which nuclear power plant licensees would develop protection systems.

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Plant Status: Operational
Fuel present at site.

Event: At approximately 12 noon, the brakes failed on a panel truck as it approached a traffic signal opposite the south gate of the station, causing the vehicle to go through the red light and crash through the unmanned, locked closed gate. The vehicle then continued to travel about 200 yards into the owner-controlled area. The distance to the station's protected area is about one mile from this point.

Action: The Seabrook police responded.

Resolution: There were no injuries, but there was minor damage to the van.

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Plant Status: NA

Event: A fission chamber detector containing 3.85 milligrams of U-235 was discovered missing from the 1 MW Triga reactor facility during a semiannual inventory.

Action: A search was conducted.

Resolution: The search results were negative; however, the licensee does not believe the detector was stolen. As a result of this event, the licensee has changed the special nuclear material accountability process.

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Plant Status: Unit 1, Operational
Fuel present at site.

Event: During efforts to consolidate radioactive material for future burial shipment, the licensee discovered the loss of ten in-core fission detectors with a total combined special nuclear material weight of approximately 0.03 grams.

Action: An extensive search for the missing material was conducted.

Resolution: The search results were negative. The licensee believes that the material was probably shipped to an off-site processing facility, processed, and shipped to the burial site.

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Plant Status: Units 1 and 2, Operational
Fuel present at site.

Event: An audit of the locations of all in-core detectors procured by the licensee since the start of plant operations has determined that the location of 5 of the total of 55 in-core detectors utilized by the facility could not be documented.

Action: The licensee conducted an investigation.

Resolution: The licensee has concluded that these detectors were probably used early in the plant life and were probably disposed of properly. Assuming that they were of the Westinghouse design, approximately 0.0205 grams of U-235 have not been documented.

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Plant Status: Unit 1, Refueling Shutdown
Unit 2, Operational
Fuel present at site.

Event: A contract firewatch employee was observed vandalizing wires and insulation in the upper cable spreading room common to both units causing minor damage to air duct insulation and to fire proofing. He was also responsible for other minor incidents of less significance.

Action: The individual's unescorted access was denied, and a security badge check was performed.

Resolution: The licensee determined that the actions appeared to be vandalism without the intent to interrupt normal operation or security and were limited to one area of the plant. There was no threat to any safety system.

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Plant Status: Units 1 and 2, Operational
Fuel present at site.

Event: At 7:50 a.m., the fire protection system for the Unit 2 main and auxiliary power transformers was activated by a security officer who pulled the switch because he was bored and wanted to see what would happen.

Action: Unescorted access was suspended for the officer who pulled the switch as well as for another officer and a security supervisor who may have had knowledge of the event.

Resolution: The licensee determined that the water deluge caused no damage to the equipment or any safety systems nor was there any change in the mode of operation of the plant due to the event.

Fuel present at site,

Event: When it was noticed that the temperature level was rising on the 1-A condenser pump bearing oil reservoir located within the turbine building, the piece of equipment was dismantled, and a foreign object was found to be causing the problem. The equipment is nonsafety-related but essential to plant operation.

Action: Security was increased, and an investigation was conducted.

Resolution: The licensee determined that this was a deliberate act of vandalism. No perpetrator was identified

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Plant Status: Unit 1, Refueling Shutdown

Fuel present at site.

Event: While reviewing the Unit 1 steam generator eddy current testing to determine why data was not being obtained, the licensee discovered that several data cables had been disconnected inside the containment building.

Action: Surveillance of the affected area was immediately increased, and a review of the personnel access records was conducted.

Resolution: The licensee determined that the cables probably could not have become disconnected accidentally and concluded that vandalism was the probable cause. No perpetrator was identified.

A further inspection determined that approximately 20 red and green valve position indicating lenses on the "A" and "B" remote shutdown panels had been swapped. The two panels are located in a vital area, in adjacent rooms, separated by a nonsecurity door.

Action: The licensee inspected other control and indication panels in Unit 2, as well as Units 1 and 3, for additional discrepancies and initiated a formal investigation.

Resolution: The investigation results were inconclusive. No perpetrator was identified.

Resolution: The results of the investigation were inconclusive. No perpetrator was identified. No subsequent damage was done.

Resolution: The contractor stated that he owned the gun for protection. He had placed the weapon in the briefcase the previous weekend during a visit to his home in Tennessee and believed that his girlfriend had subsequently removed it. The licensee determined that there was no malevolent intent.

Resolution: The individual stated that he had been shooting over the weekend and had forgotten that the weapon was in his duffle bag. The licensee determined that there was no malevolent intent.

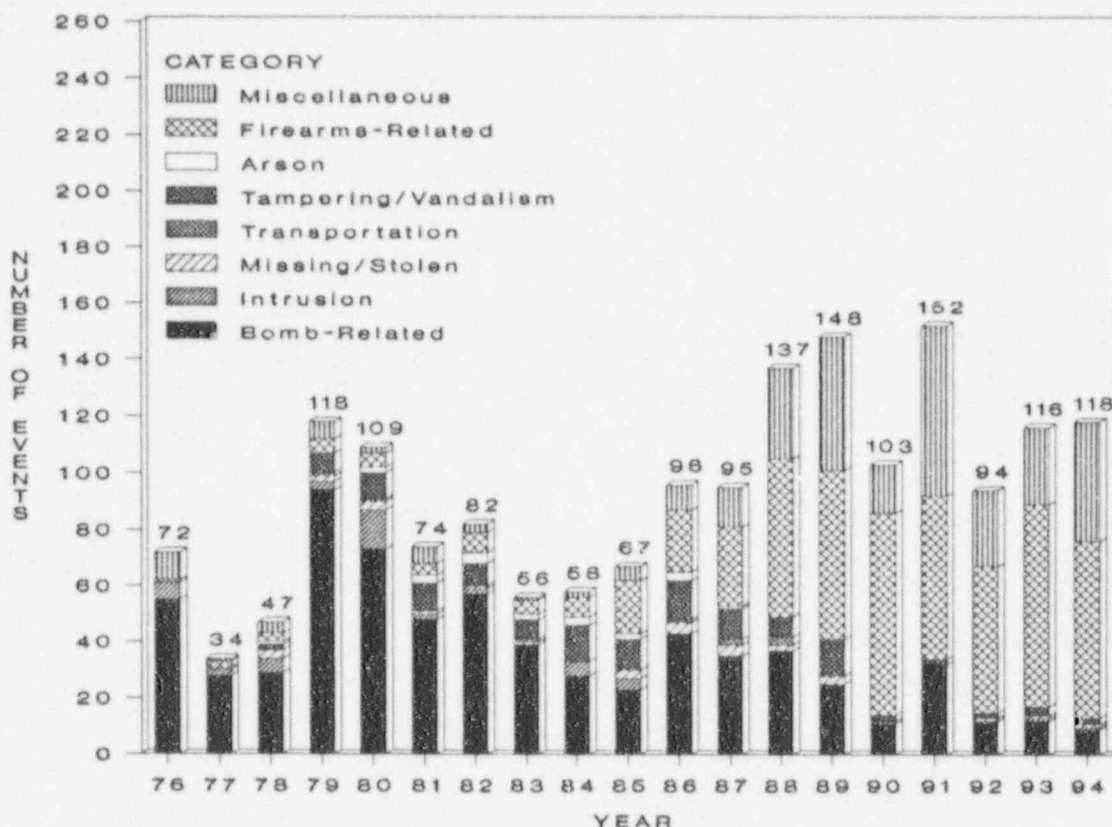

Figure 1 reflects the numerical distribution by year and category of the 1776 safeguards events reported through December 31, 1994.

After a roughly 151 percent increase in events reported between 1978 and 1979 (the result of a change in reporting requirements, an increase in events reported following the TMI March 1979 occurrence, and contentious licensing hearings), totals reported by year declined somewhat and remained relatively stable until 1986 (96*) which experienced a 43 percent increase over 1985 (67). Events reported remained stable in 1987, increased in 1988 (137) and 1989 (148), declined by 30 percent in 1990 (103) from 1989, but increased by 48 percent in 1991 (152) from 1990. The rise in 1991 was due to an increase in bomb threats and miscellaneous threats reported in the first few months of 1991 during the Persian Gulf crises, as well as an increase in events involving safeguards information and contraband. During 1992, the 94 events reported reflected a decline of 38 percent from 1991, primarily because of a drop in bomb-threats and miscellaneous events reported. In 1993, the 116 safeguards events reported represented an increase of 23 percent from 1992 as a result of an increase in firearms events reported.

In 1994, there were 118 events reported, reflecting an increase of 1.7 percent over 1993. The rise is attributable to the increase in the miscellaneous category; all other categories of reported events declined.

REACTOR SAFEGUARDS EVENTS (1691*) 1976 - 1994

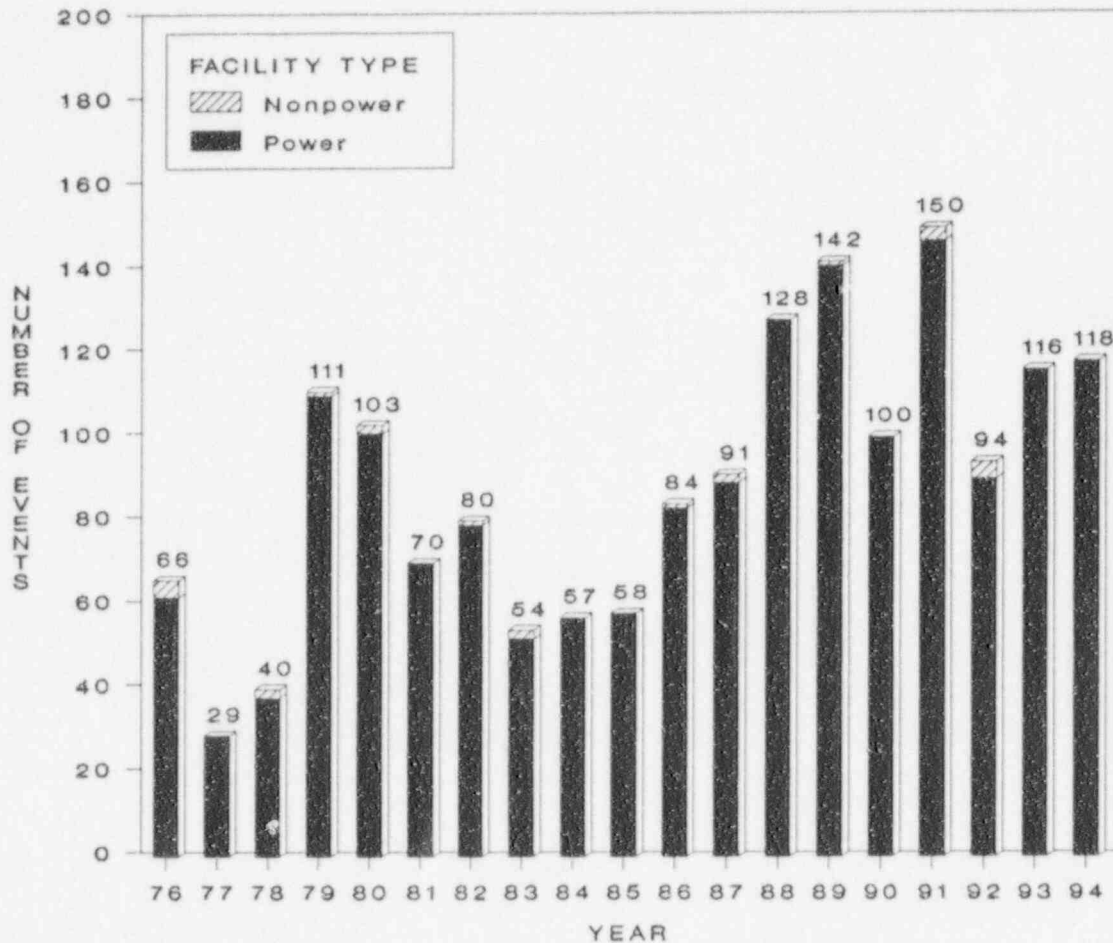

Figure 2 shows the number of safeguards events (1691) that have occurred at reactors.

Although reactor safeguards events declined 29 percent in 1990 (100) from 1989 (142), there was an increase of 50 percent in 1991 (150) over 1990 for the reasons stated in Figure 1. During 1992, there were 94 reactor safeguards events reported, reflecting a decline of 37 percent from 1991, primarily in bomb threats and miscellaneous events reported. Reactor safeguards events reported in 1993 rose to 116, an increase of 23 percent over 1992, attributable to the increase in firearms events reported.

In 1994, there were 118 events reported. As stated in Figure 1, the small increase of 2 events (1.7 percent) is attributable to the rise in the miscellaneous events category.

NONREACTOR SAFEGUARDS EVENTS (85) 1976 - 1994

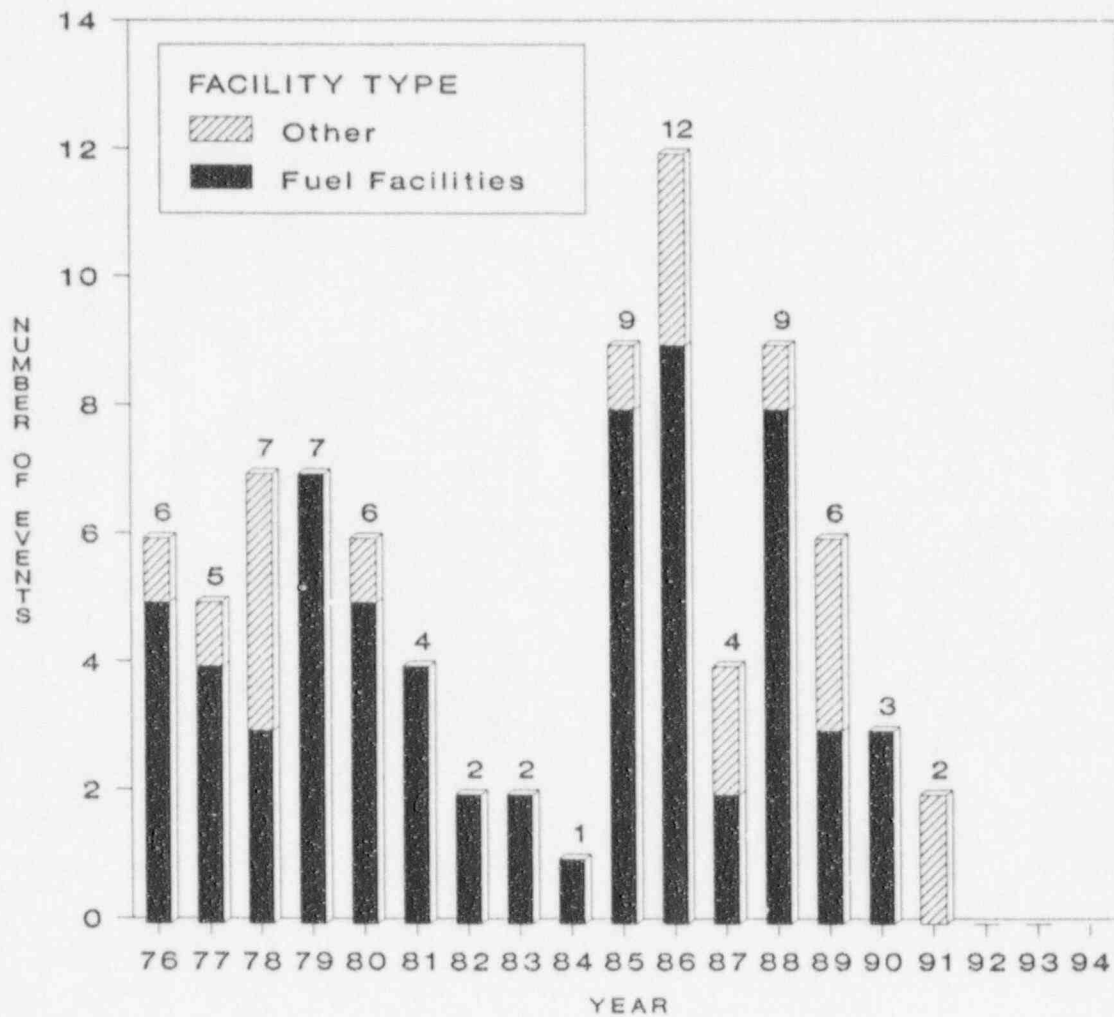

Figure 3 shows event activity for nonreactor facilities. After declining 33 percent in 1989 (6) from 1988 (9), there was a further decline of 50 percent in 1990 (3) from 1989, and a decline of 33 percent in 1991 (2). During 1992, 1993, and 1994, there were no nonreactor safeguards events reported.

This category includes events which have occurred at fuel facilities (66) as well as events which are included because of public interest (19), but which occurred at facilities or activities that are not safeguarded under NRC regulations.

SG EVENTS (1086) EXCLUDING BOMB-RELATED 1976 - 1994

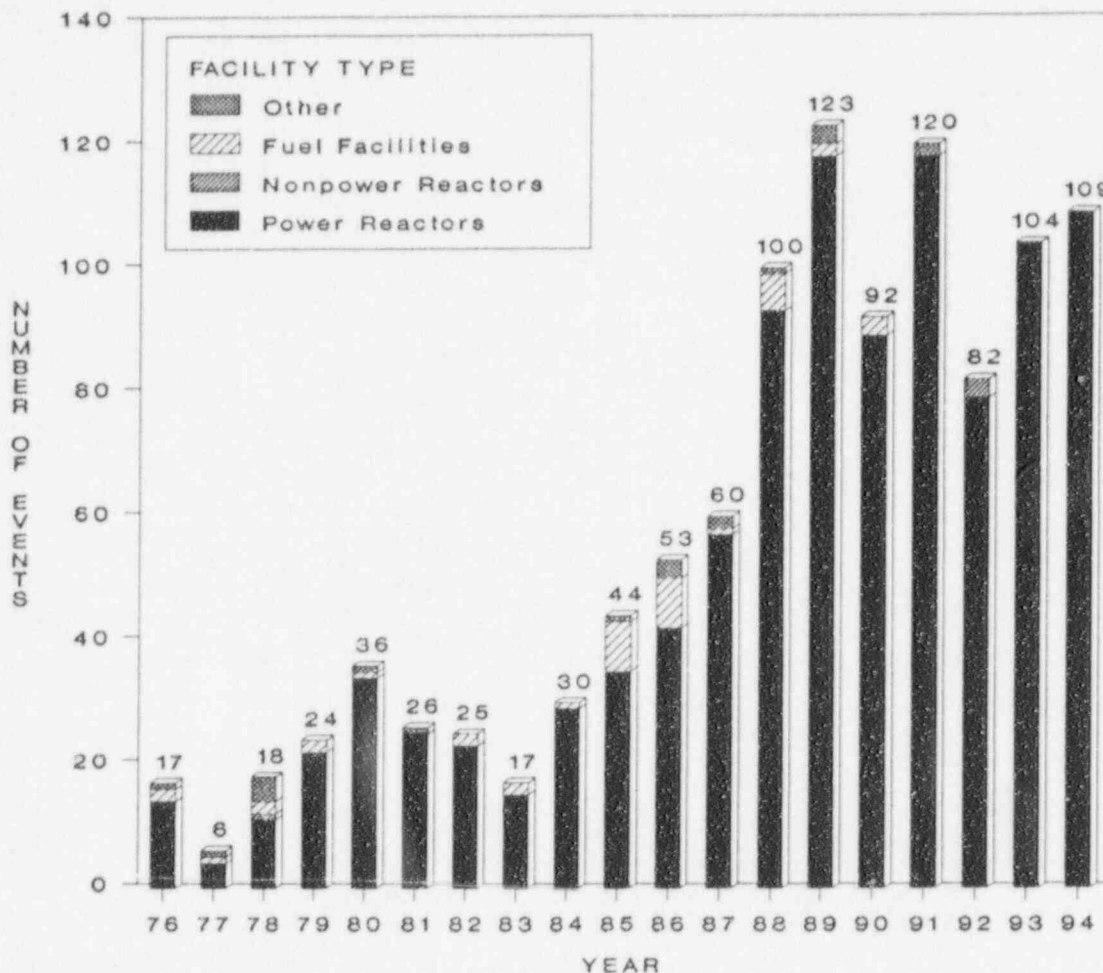

Figure 4 shows the trend in nonbomb-related safeguards events.

After a marked increase in nonbomb-related safeguards events of 67 percent in 1988 (100) over 1987 (60), there was a moderate increase of 23 percent in 1989 (123) over 1988, and a decline of 25 percent in 1990 (92) from 1989. However, 1991 (120) increased by 30 percent over 1990, for some of the reasons stated in Figure 1. During 1992, there were 82 nonbomb-related safeguards events reported, reflecting a decline of 32 percent from 1991, primarily in the reported miscellaneous events (safeguards information, general threats, contraband, etc.). Nonbomb-related safeguards events reported in 1993 (104) increased by 27 percent over the previous year, due to an increase in the firearms events reported.

In 1994, nonbomb-related safeguards events increased to 109, 5 percent over the previous year, due to the rise in the miscellaneous events reported.

REACTOR SAFEGUARDS EVENTS (1025) EXCLUDING BOMB-RELATED EVENTS 1976 - 1994

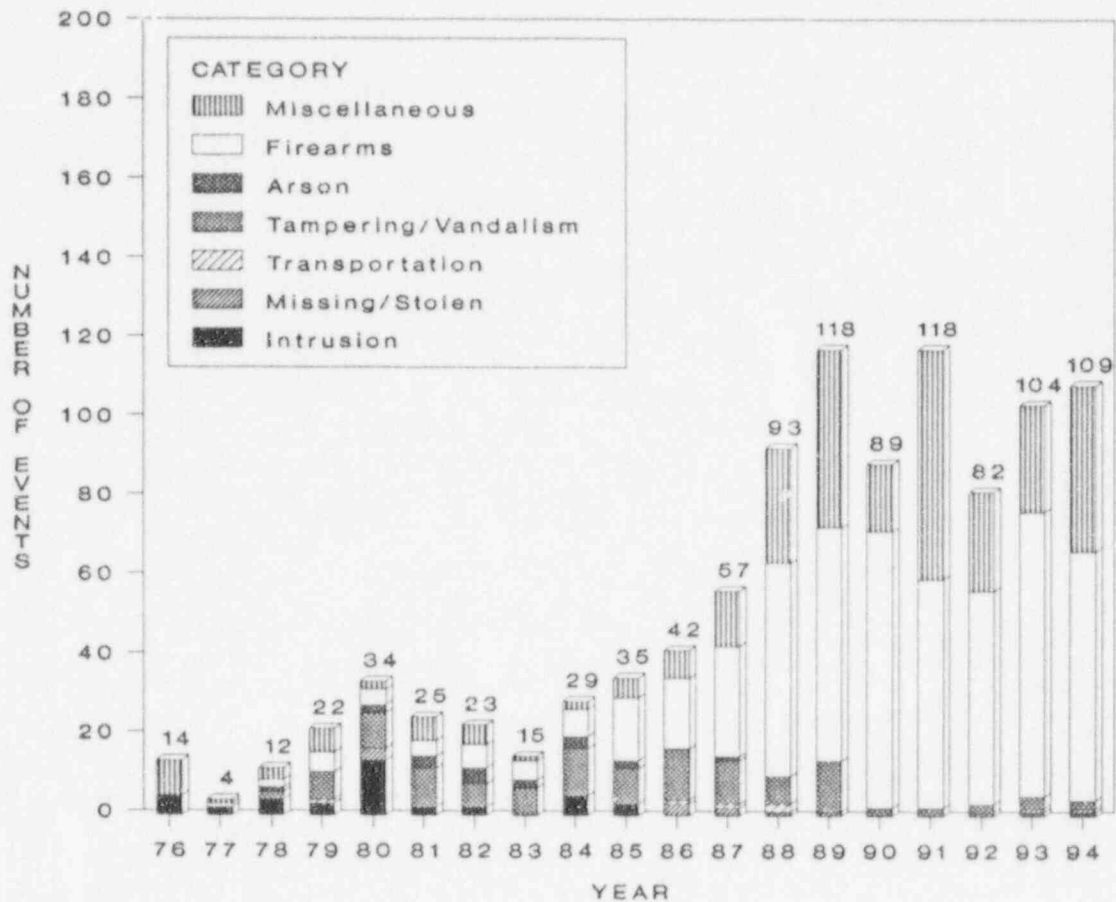

Figure 5 shows the frequency of reactor safeguards events, excluding bomb hoaxes/devices, which is usually sensitive to the increase in the number of facilities.

After rising steadily from 1983 (15) to 1989 (118), this category of events fell 25 percent in 1990 (89) from 1989, but increased by 32 percent in 1991 (118) due to the increase in the miscellaneous category of events which includes the reported loss of safeguards information, attempted introduction of contraband, general threats, etc. During 1992, there were 82 reactor safeguards events, excluding bomb hoaxes/devices, reflecting a 31 percent decline from 1991, because of a decrease in the reported miscellaneous events. This category of events increased in 1993 (104) by 27 percent over 1992, due to the increase in firearms events reported.

In 1994, 109 reactor safeguards events, excluding bomb-related events, were reported, reflecting a 5 percent increase from 1993. As previously stated, the increase was due to the rise in miscellaneous events reported.

SAFEGUARDS EVENTS BY CATEGORY 1993 (116) VS. 1994 (118)

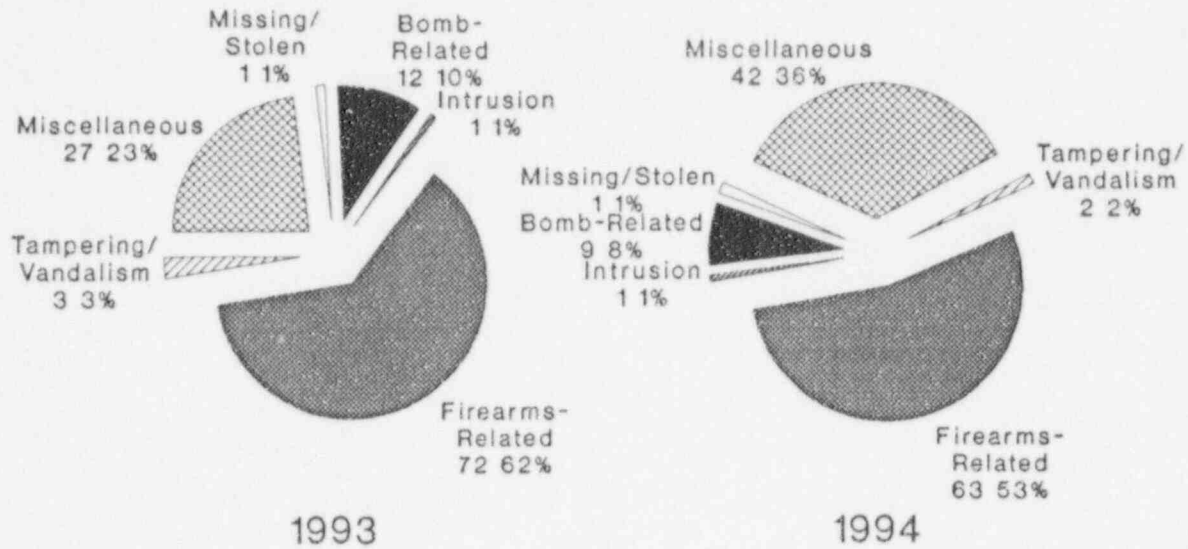

Figure 6 displays the events by categories and reveals some change in the percentage of distribution of events in several categories: Bomb-Related (10 percent in 1993 vs. 8 percent in 1994); Firearms-Related (62 percent in 1993 vs. 53 percent in 1994); and Miscellaneous (23 percent in 1993 vs. 36 percent in 1994).

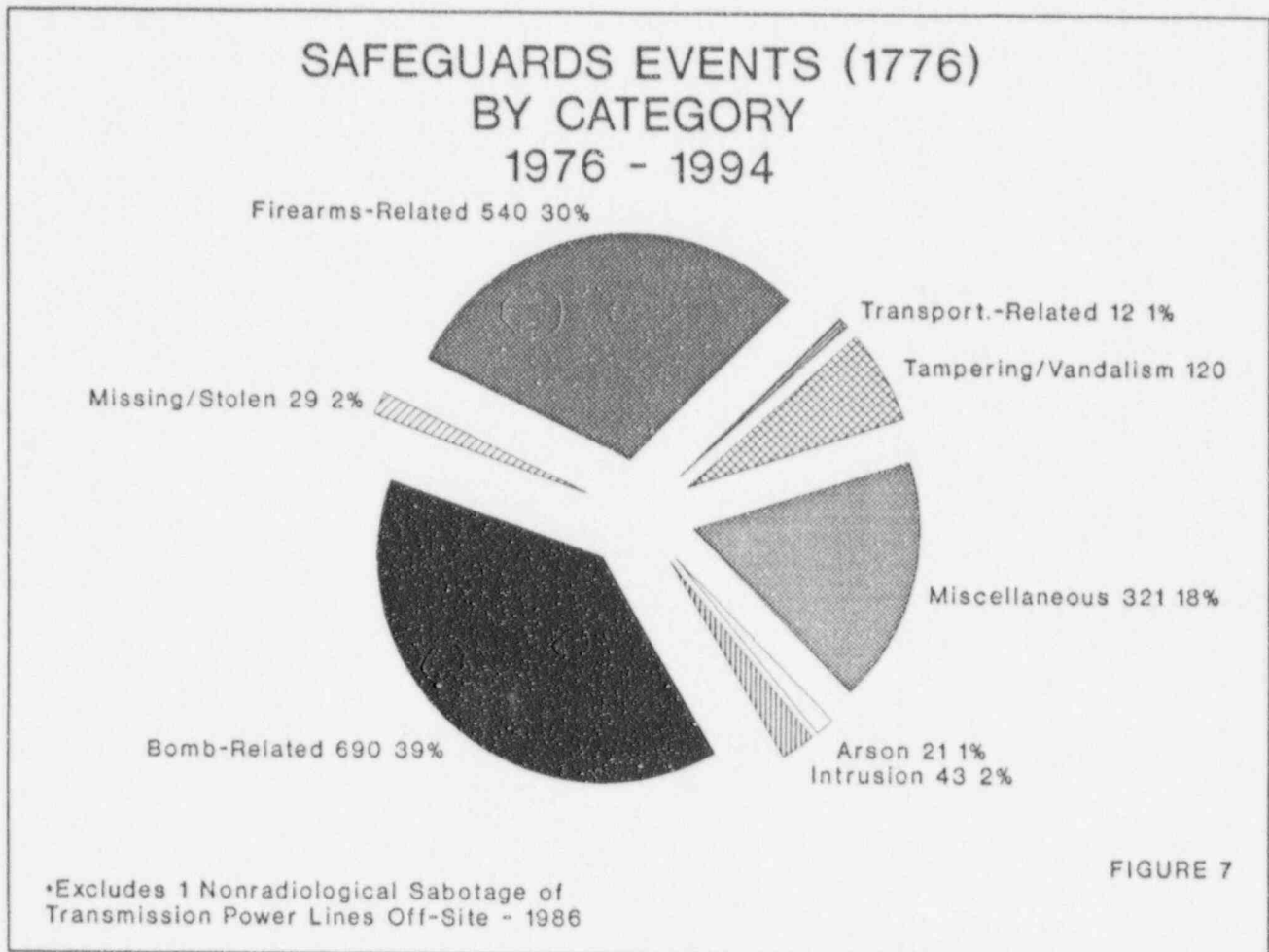


Figure 7 displays the events by categories covering the 19-year period from 1976 through 1994 and, like Figure 6, reveals a substantial change in percentage of distribution of events in several categories: Bomb-Related (39 percent 1976-1994 vs. 8 percent in 1994); Firearms-Related (30 percent 1976-1994 vs. 53 percent for 1994); and Miscellaneous (18 percent 1976-1994 vs. 36 percent in 1994).

BOMB-RELATED EVENTS (690) 1976 - 1994

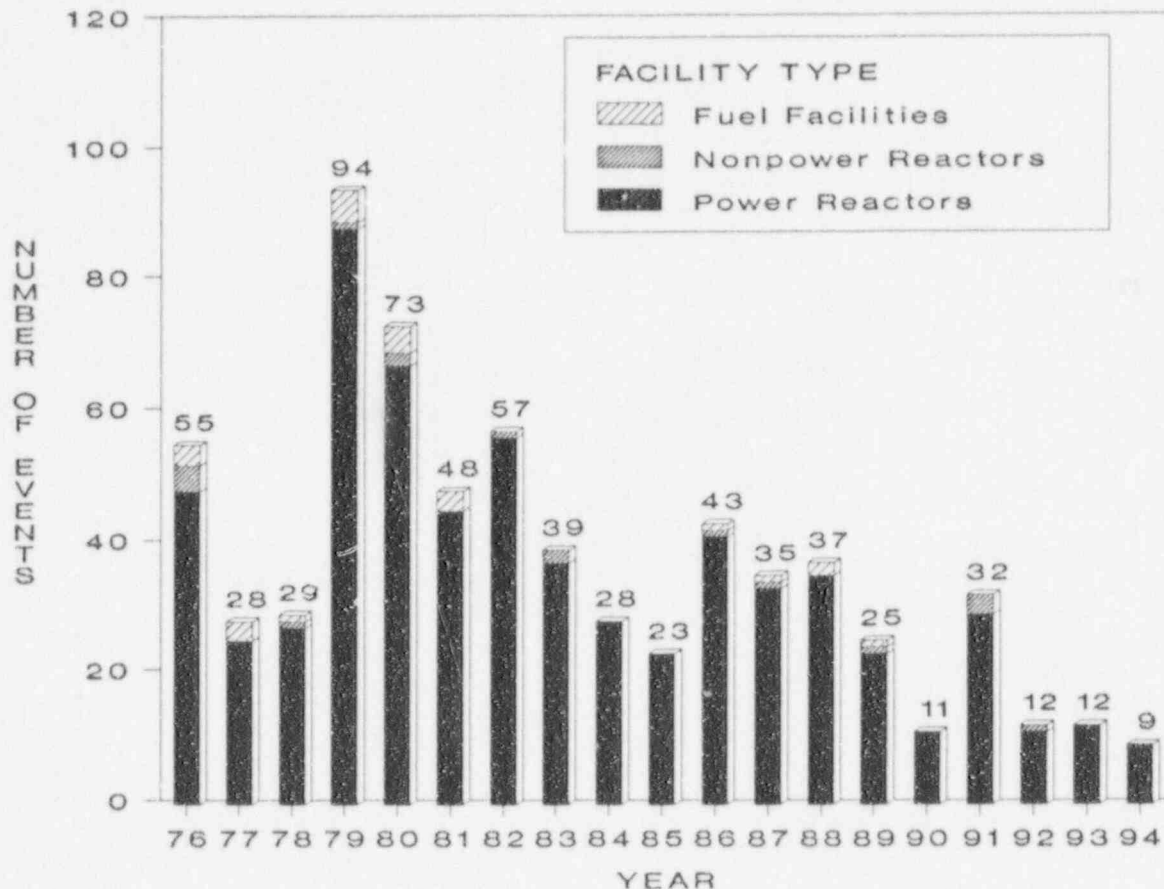

Figure 8 shows the number of bomb-related incidents over the 19-year reporting period.

Bomb threats, which declined considerably after reaching a peak of 94 in 1979, reached a low level in 1990 (11), a 56 percent drop from 1989 (25). Of the 11 events in 1990, 4 occurred at a facility granted a full power license in March 1990. However, there was a 191 percent increase in 1991 (32) over 1990; 16 (50 percent) of the 32 were received during January and February and may be attributed to the crisis in the Persian Gulf. During 1992, there were 12 bomb-related events versus 32 for 1991, a decrease of 63 percent. Three power reactor facilities received 2 threats each through the 3rd quarter accounting for 50 percent of the threats received, and 1 threat was directed at a nonpower reactor facility. During 1993, the number of bomb-related events reported remained stable (12), all at power reactor facilities.

Bomb-related events reported reached an all-time low in 1994 (9), a 25 percent drop from 1993. One facility accounted for 3 of the reported events.

INTRUSION EVENTS (43) 1976 - 1994

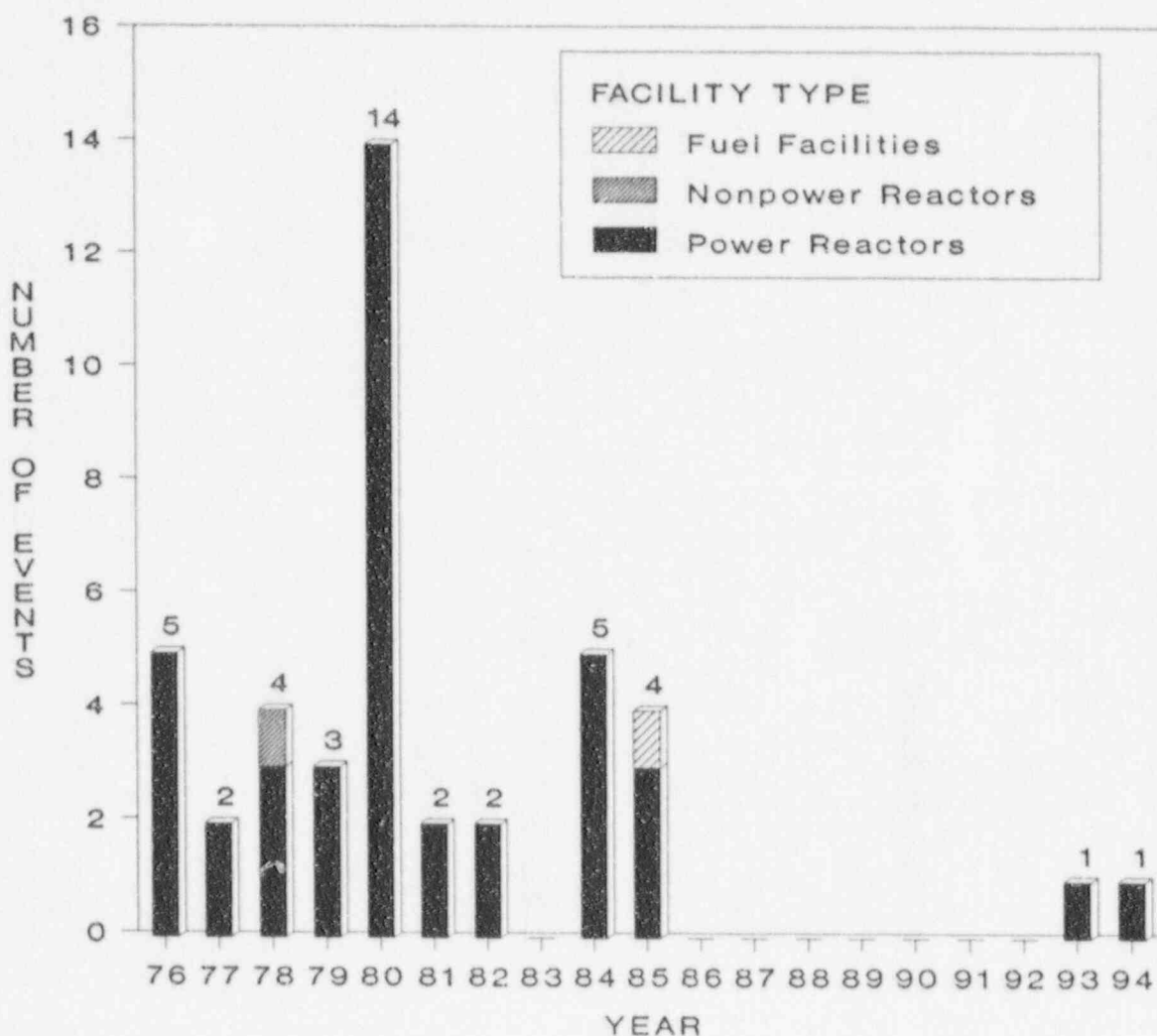

Figure 9 plots the number of intrusion events which have occurred.

With the exception of 1980 (14), there have been relatively few intrusion events. There were no intrusion events in 1983 and none for the period 1986 through 1992. During 1993, the first reported intrusion event since 1985 occurred at a reactor site. This 1993 event led to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's decision to modify the design basis threat for radiological sabotage, 10 CFR 73.1, to include the use of a land-based vehicle by an adversary.

During 1994, there was 1 intrusion event reported; a van's brakes failed causing the vehicle to crash the gate into the owner-controlled area.

MISSING/STOLEN EVENTS (29) 1976 - 1994

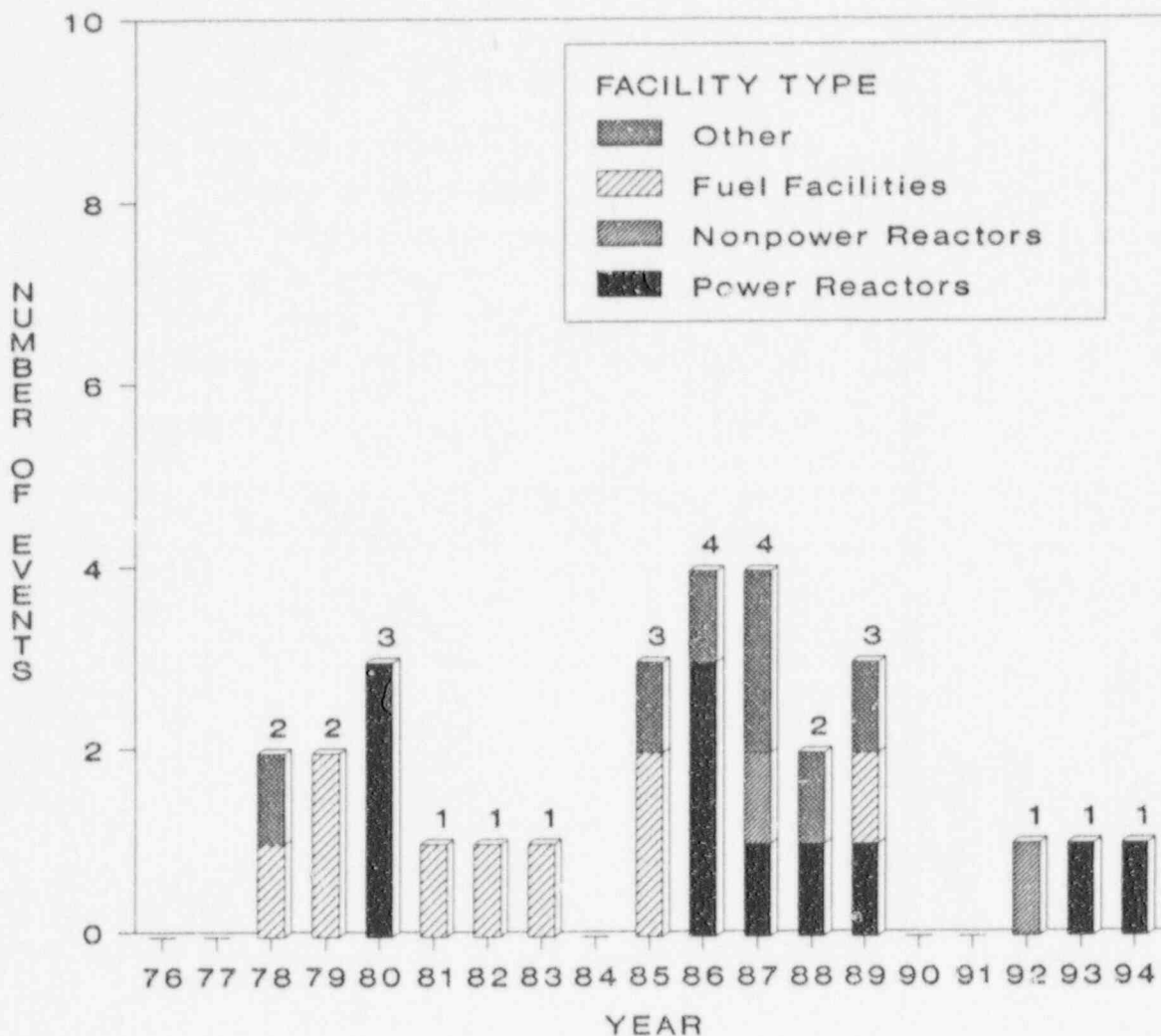


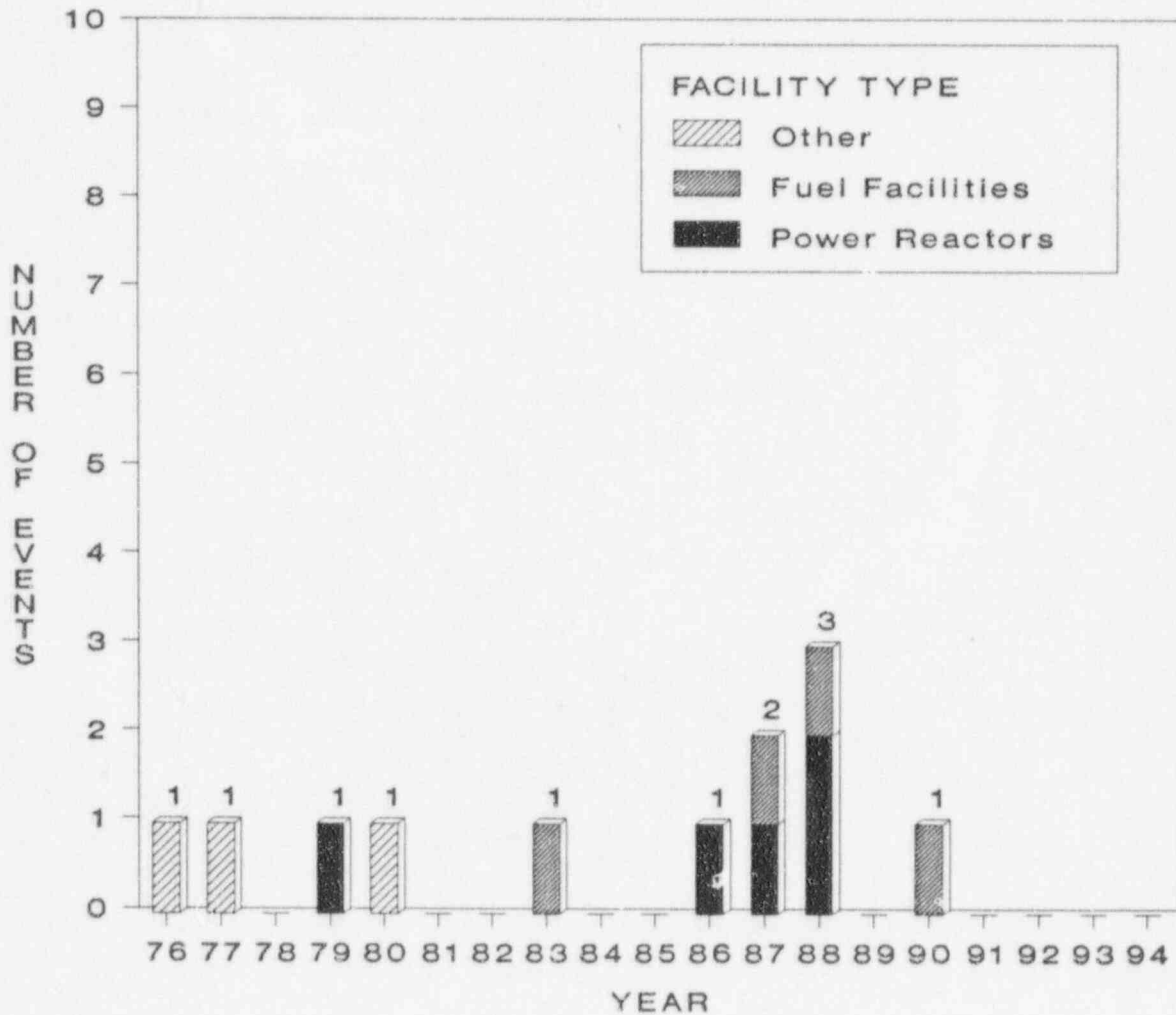

Figure 10 presents the missing and stolen events involving safeguarded material.

Missing and stolen events reported range from 1 to 4 events per year, with none reported for the period 1976, 1977, 1984, 1990, and 1991. There was 1 event involving missing safeguarded material at a nonpower reactor in 1992. In 1993, a nuclear power plant reported 1 event concerning missing fission detectors containing special nuclear material.

In 1994, as in the previous year, 1 event was reported concerning missing detectors at a nuclear power facility.

Figure 11 covers the few transportation events involving safeguarded material.

Transportation reported events range from 1 to 3 per year, with none reported for 1978, 1981, 1982, 1984, 1985, 1989, and 1991 through 1994. Note that to avoid double counting, events which were cross-referenced in the transportation category have not been included.

TAMPERING/VANDALISM EVENTS (120) 1976 - 1994

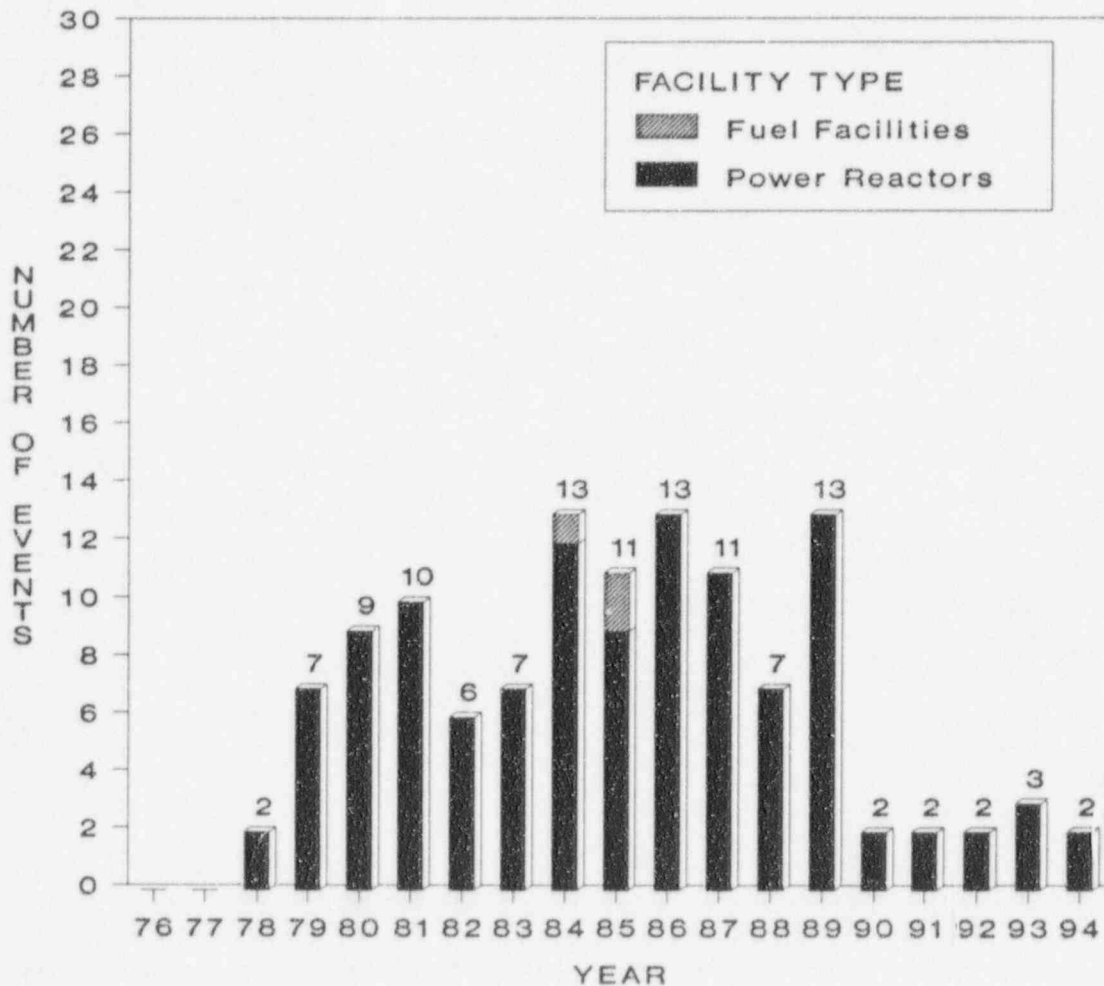

Figure 12 depicts the tampering and vandalism events.

This class of events has been relatively stable even though there has been an increase in the number of regulated facilities. There was an increase in events reported of 86 percent in 1989 (13) vs. 1988 (7), but a decline of 85 percent in 1990 (2) from 1989. There was no change in the number of tampering and vandalism events reported in 1991 (2) or 1992 (2), but there was a 50 percent increase in 1993 (3) in the reported events of this type, 2 of which occurred at the same facility.

In 1994, the tampering and vandalism events reported (2) declined by 33 percent to the 1990, 1991, and 1992 level.

ARSON EVENTS (21) 1976 - 1994

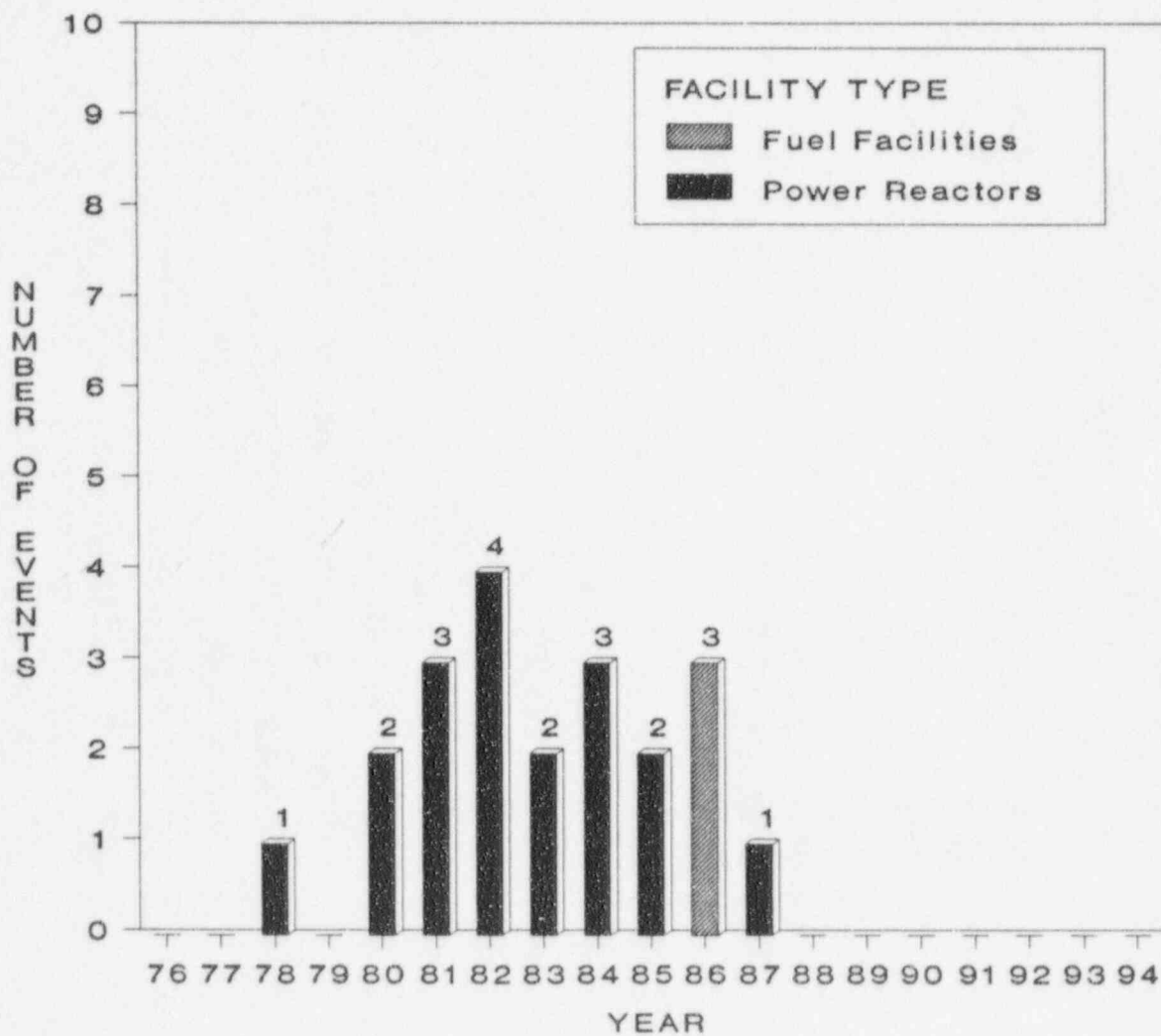

Figure 13 shows the small number of arson events with none reported for 1976, 1977, 1979, and for the period 1988 through 1994.

FIREARMS EVENTS (540) 1976 - 1994

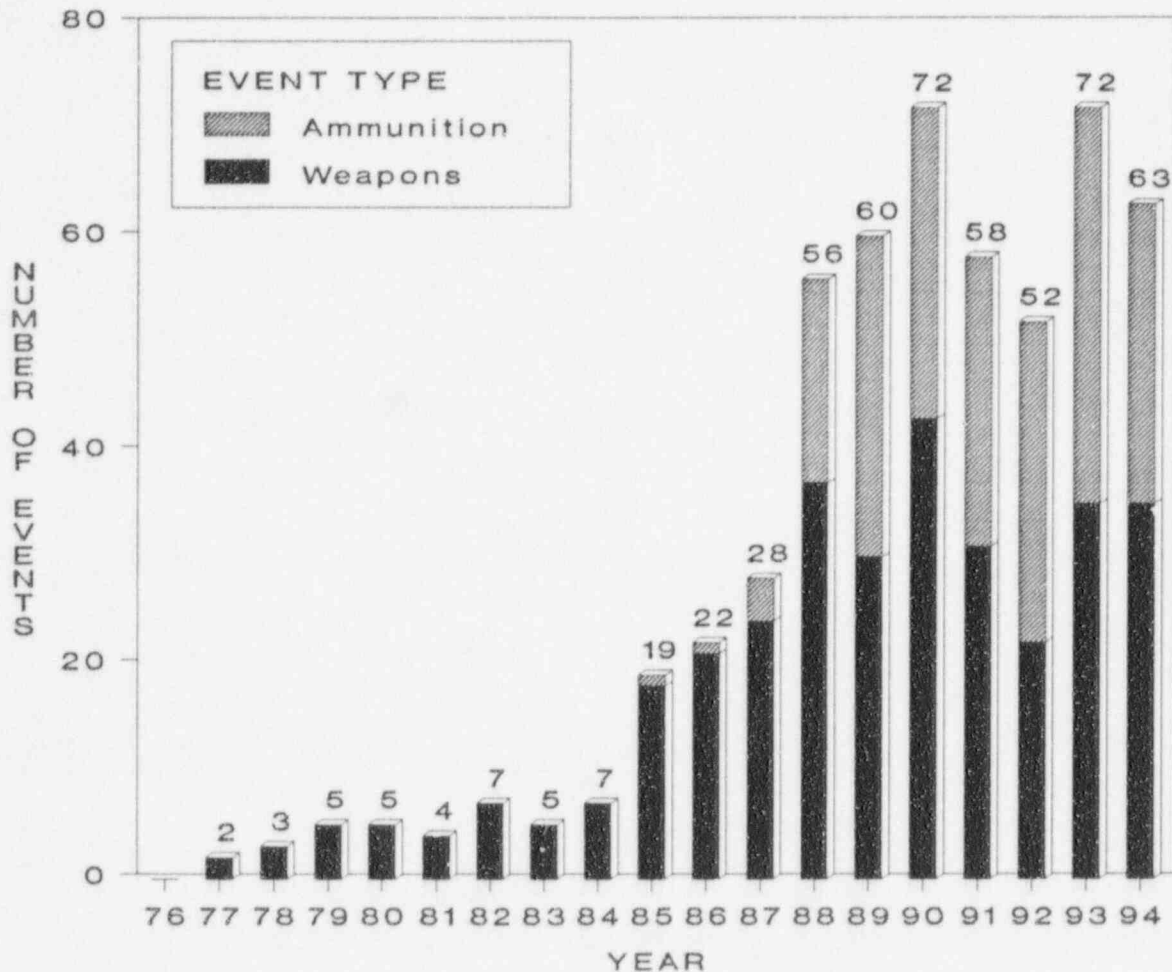

Figure 14 displays the number of firearms-related events that have occurred at all facilities.

After rising steadily, increasing by 100 percent in 1988 (56) vs. 1987 (28), by 7 percent in 1989 (60) over 1988 and 20 percent in 1990 (72) from 1989, there was a decline of 19 percent in 1991 (58) and a further decline of 10 percent in 1992 (52) in firearms reported events. It should be noted that from 1987 to date, there has been an increase in events reported involving ammunition detection (no weapon involved). Of the 72 firearms-related events reported for 1990, 43 (60 percent) involved weapons and 29 (40 percent) ammunition only; in 1991, 31 (53 percent) involved weapons and 27 (47 percent) ammunition only; in 1992, 22 (42 percent) involved weapons and 30 (58 percent) involved ammunition only; and in 1993, 35 (49 percent) involved weapons and 37 events (51 percent) involved ammunition only.

In 1994, firearms events reported (63) declined by nearly 13 percent from the previous year (72). Thirty-five (56 percent) involved weapons and 28 (44 percent) involved ammunition only.

MISCELLANEOUS EVENTS (321) 1976 - 1994

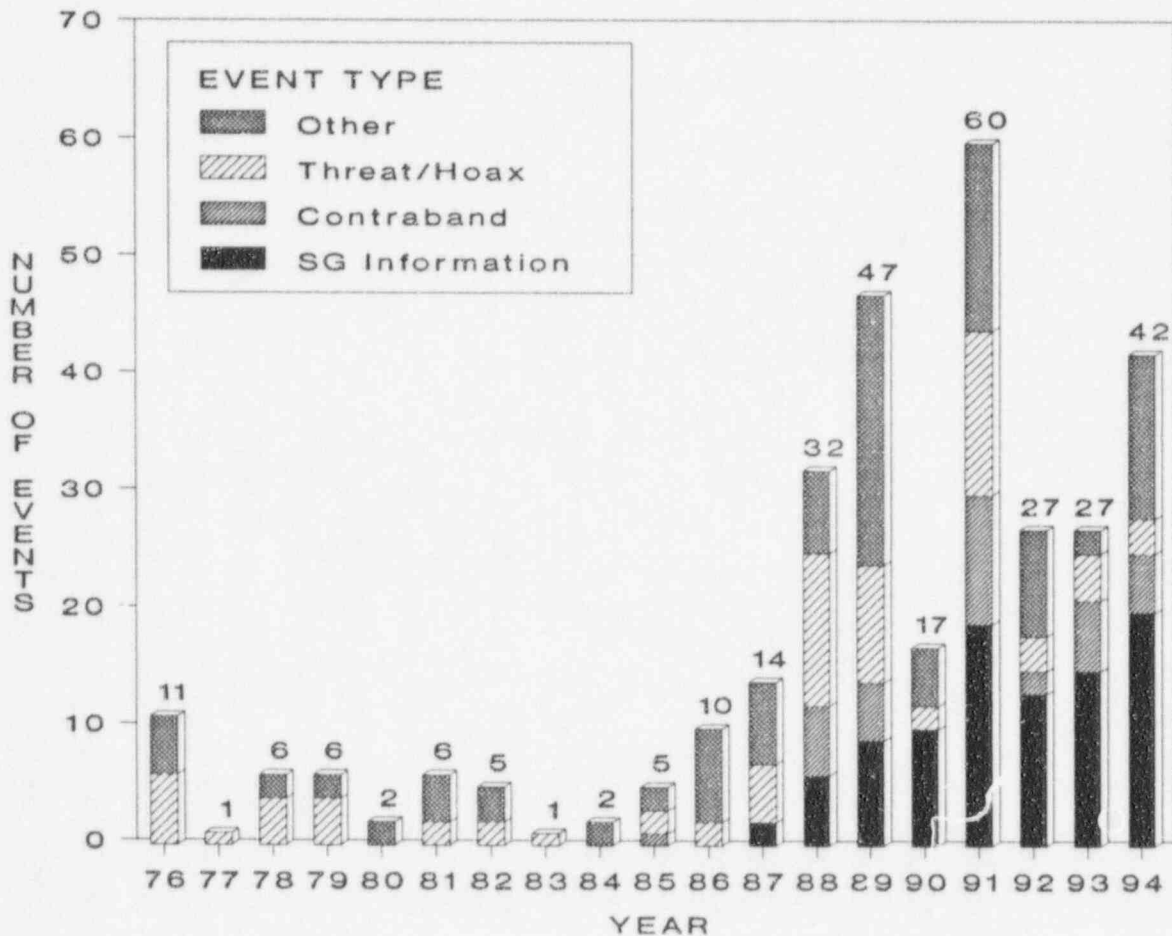

Figure 15 plots the miscellaneous events reported. This category includes not only safeguard events which do not properly fit into any of the categories defined in the document, but also covers events which involve persons or materials not subject to NRC safeguards regulations, but which are of interest to the Commission, the industry, and the public.

There was a rise in the miscellaneous events reported of 129 percent in 1988 (32) over 1987 (14), a rise of 47 percent in 1989 (47) over 1988, a decline of 64 percent in 1990 (17) from 1989, but a marked increase of 253 percent in 1991 (60). Once again, significant numbers of events occurred in January and February of 1991 and may be attributed to the Persian Gulf crises. The 1991 high of 60 events was followed by a decline of 55 percent in 1992 (27). Miscellaneous events reported remained stable during 1993 (27).

In 1994, the miscellaneous events reported (42) increased 56 percent over 1993. Twenty events (48 percent) related to safeguards information (15 1993); 5 (12 percent) to contraband other than firearms (6 1993); 3 (7 percent) to general threats (4 1993); and 14 (33 percent) to other types. Note that the miscellaneous category of events reported is the only category of events which increased in 1994; all other categories declined.

U.S. COMMERCIAL POWER REACTORS LICENSED TO OPERATE 109 - END OF 1994

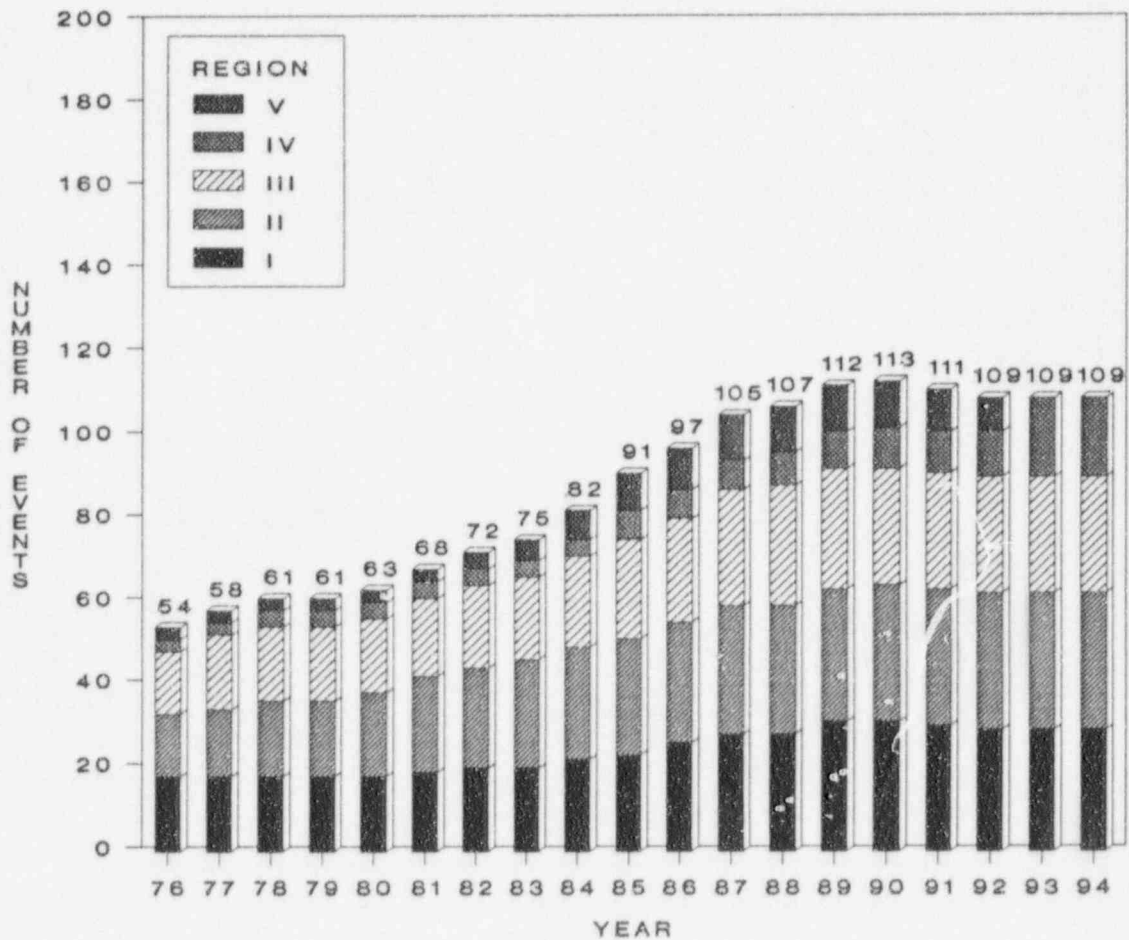

Figure 16 depicts the number of reactors operating for the period 1976-1994 by NRC Region. As of the end of 1994, there were 109 power reactors licensed to operate: Region I, 29 (27 percent); Region II, 33 (30 percent); Region III, 28 (26 percent); and Region IV, 19 (17 percent). Note that during 1993, Region V was merged with Region IV.

Because of the public interest, the Miscellaneous category also includes events reported involving source material, byproduct material, and natural uranium, which are exempt from safeguards requirements. Information in the event descriptions was obtained from official NRC sources.
