Dear Mr. Guste:

Your June 30, 1984 letter to Chairman Palladino has been referred to me for response. Your letter indicates that you have decided against filing any formal petition in the Grand Gulf Nuclear Station licensing proceeding. Accordingly, the Commission took no action in response to your June 25, 1984 request that the Commission delay action on the Grand Gulf Nuclear Station license application.

The Commission authorized issuance of a full power license for the Grand Gulf Nuclear Station at a July 31, 1984 Commission meeting. Commission authorization of a full power license reflects the Commission's conclusion that the health and safety of the public is adequately protected.
