SUBJECT: DOCKET NOS. 50-413 AND 50-414

This acknowledges the receipt of your letter of December 27, 1991, concerning Revision 29 to the Physical Security Plan, Revision 12 to the Safeguards Contingency Plan, and Revision 15 to the Training and Qualification Plan for your Catawba facility.

Based on a telephone conversation between Ms. C. Masnyk of the NRC and Mr. T. Byers of the Catawba site on January 7, 1992, we understand that you will clarify the following portions of these revisions and submit page changes when complete. The original discussion of the annual and independent audits of the security plans and program to include the scope of the audits will be replaced in Section 1.5 of the Contingency Plan and Section 14.1 of the Physical Security Plan. The nature of the perimeter intrusion system in Section 10.2.5 of the Physical Security Plan will be clarified. Editorial changes to Section 1.2.1.4 of the Training and Qualification Plan in reference to alarm station operators will be made.

Our review of the changes has found them to be consistent with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(p). Accordingly, they are acceptable for inclusion into the plan.

The enclosure to your letter is being withheld from public disclosure because it contains Safeguards Information and must be protected in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR Part 73.21.

Should you have any questions concerning this letter, we will be glad to discuss them with you.
