Cook of your staff via a telephone call on January 9, 1992, at the conclusion of the inspection.

The enclosed copy of our inspection report identifies areas examined during the inspection. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, and interviews with personnel.

During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in violation of NRC requirements. However, as described in the enclosed inspection report, the violation was categorized at Severity Level V and it is not ' .g cited because the criteria in Section V.A of the "General Statement . Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Action," (Enforcement Policy, 10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C (1991), were satisfied.
