ORDER GRANTING "LILCO'S MOTION TO COMPEL THE IDENTIFICATION
OF WITNESSES OFFERING SPECIFIC ELEMENTS OF TESTIMONY REGARDING
SUFFOLK COUNTY'S EMERGENCY DIESEL GENERATOR CONTENTIONS"

The above-captioned motion, filed by LILCO on August 7, 1984, is granted. The Board had been considering ordering, on its own, the identification requested by LILCO. The general description of the subject areas in which each of the six witnesses participated, provided at the beginning of the County's 184 pages of testimony, is too vague to provide the information necessary to determine precisely which witness or witnesses provided each answer in the testimony.


