This letter confirms verbal authorization provided to your office by RoseMary Mann, of my staff, to commence work under the subject task order effective January 10, 1932, with a temporary ceiling of \$10,000.00.

In accordance with the task order procedures of the subject contract, this letter definitizes Task Order No. 46. This effort shall be performed in accordance with the enclosed Statement of Work, the Contractor's revised proposal dated January 16, 1992 and the following telephonic changes:

- Reduced fixed fee on January 29, 1992 by \$277.59 from \$1,721.08 (7.75%) to \$1,443.49 (6.5%).
- The completion of the final documentation report will take place at the contractors's home office instead Region V (see attached revised Statement of Work) as negotiated January 10, 1992.

Task Order No. 46 shall be in effect from January 10, 1992 through March 31, 1992, with a cost ceiling of \$90,426.32. The amount of \$88,982.83 represents the total estimated reimbursable costs, and the amount of \$1,443.49 represents the fixed fee.
