This letter is sent to acknowledge receipt for your request, dated June 29, 1984, for action under 10 CFR 2.206 with respect to the Farley Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2. Your petition asks for enforcement action with respect to the antitrust license conditions in the Farley licenses. Although your letter was directed to Mr. DeYoung, the Director of the Office of Inspection and Enforcement, antitrust enforcement matters are usually handled by the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation.

As you are probably aware, the Commission issued an order on July 9, 1984 asking for comments by Alabama Electric Cooperative and any other interested parties with respect to the choice of procedures to be followed in resolving the differences between Alabama Power Company and Alabama Electric Cooperative in this matter. Therefore, pursuant to the Commission's order, your petition under section 2.206 will be held in abeyance pending further direction of the Commission.
