Gentlemen:

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We have received your quality assurance program submittal of June 6, 1984, for Clinton Power Station Unit No. 1. Please be advised that Paragraph (3)(ii) of 10 CFR 50.55(f) requires the following then changes to the quality assurance program description reduce prior commitments:

The submittal of a change to the Safety Analysis Report quality assurance program description must include all pages affected by that change and must be accompanied by a forwarding letter identifying the change, the reason for the change, and the basis for concluding that the revised program incorporating the change continues to satisfy the criteria of Appendix B of this part and the Safety Analysis Report quality assurance program description commitments previously accepted by the NRC (the letter need not provide the basis for changes that correct spelling, punctuation, or editorial items).

Because each change to the program is considered to represent a potential reduction in commitment, the requirements of Paragraph (3)(ii) apply. Accordingly, your submittal letter for each revision to the program description should satisfy this requirement by (1) identifying each change, (2) the reason for each change, and (3) the basis for concluding that the revised program incorporating each change continues to satisfy the criteria of 10 CFR 50, Appendix B and the Safety Analysis Report quality assurance program description commitments.

Your letter of submittal which forwards quality assurance program description changes is not in accordance with the requirements of Paragraph (3)(ii) of 10 CFR 50.55(f). Therefore, we request that your submittal be revised to fully comply with the requirements and that it be forwarded to this office within 30 days of the receipt of this letter.


