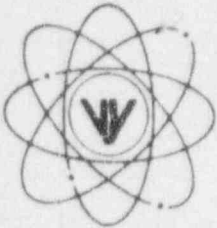

Subject: Correction to Letter Submitting YAEC-1926, "Yankee Atomic Electric Company Application of BWROG Stability Exclusion Region Methodology for Implementation of Long Term Solution Option 1-D at Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Station"

In reference (c), Vermont Yankee stated its intention to apply the subject methodology in calculating the power/flow exclusion region boundary in the Vermont Yankee Core Operating Limits Report and reference the subject report to meet the requirements of reference (d). However, we mistakenly added the qualification that we would apply the methodology "upon the receipt of an NRC SER approving its use." We realize that an NRC SER is not necessarily required in that the methodology represents Vermont Yankee's implementation of the BWROG methodology approved in reference (b). Therefore, we ask that the NRC disregard the statement "upon receipt of an NRC SER approving its use" stated in reference (c).

We appreciate your consideration in this matter and trust the information provided is acceptable; however, should you have any further questions, please contact this office.

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
